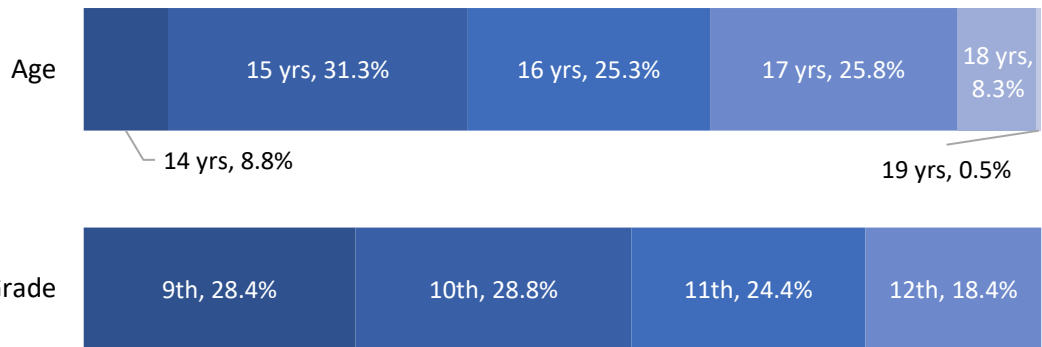

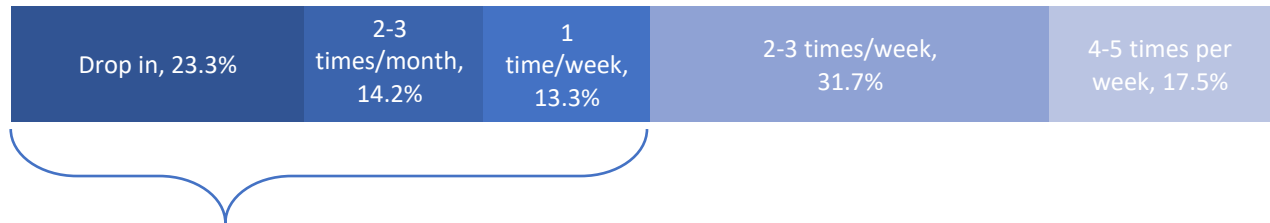

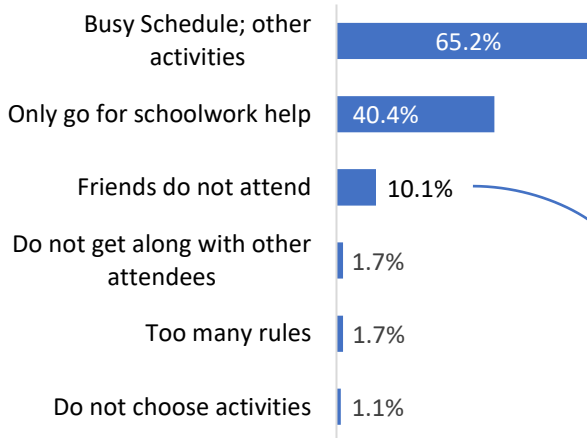
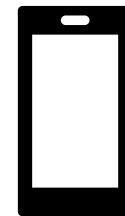
Attendance



Current Participation:



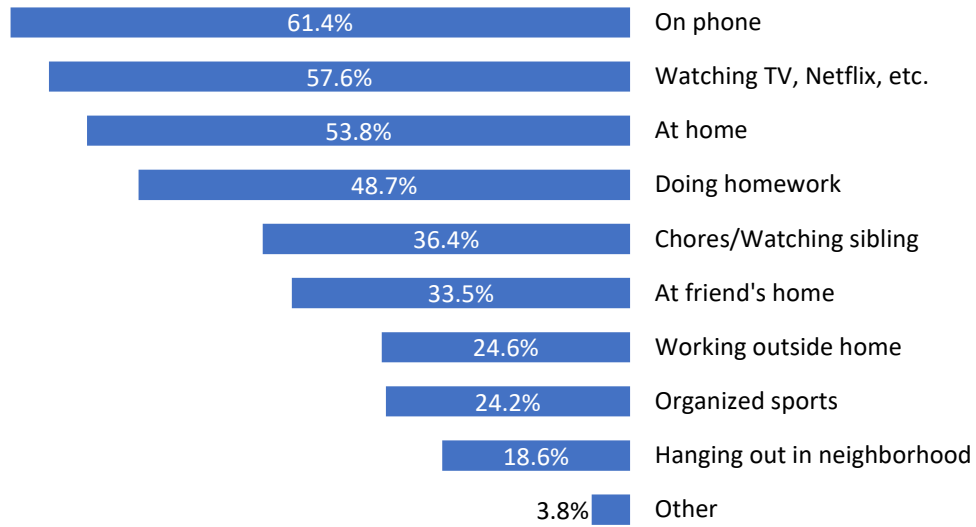
Of the students who reported attending 3 times per week or less (50.8%), the following are reasons they do not attend more frequently²:



Reasons their friends do not attend²:

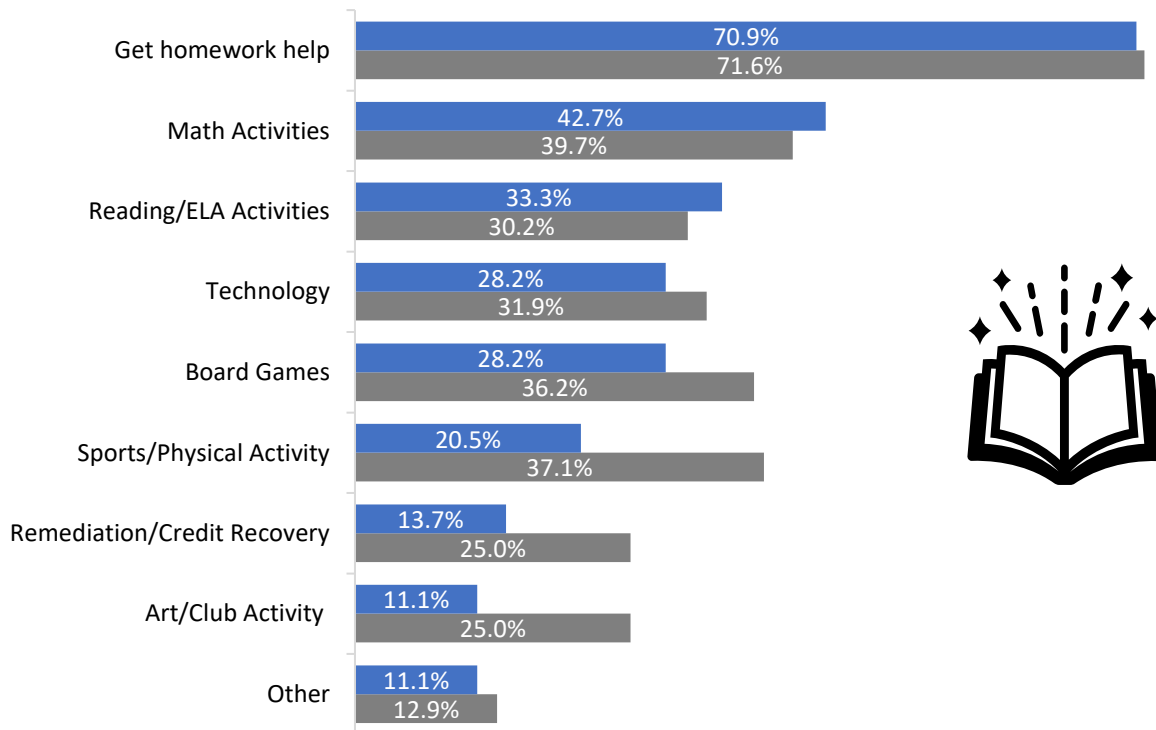
- Have to go home (38.9%)

Students provided short-answer responses to the following question - **“If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?”**:

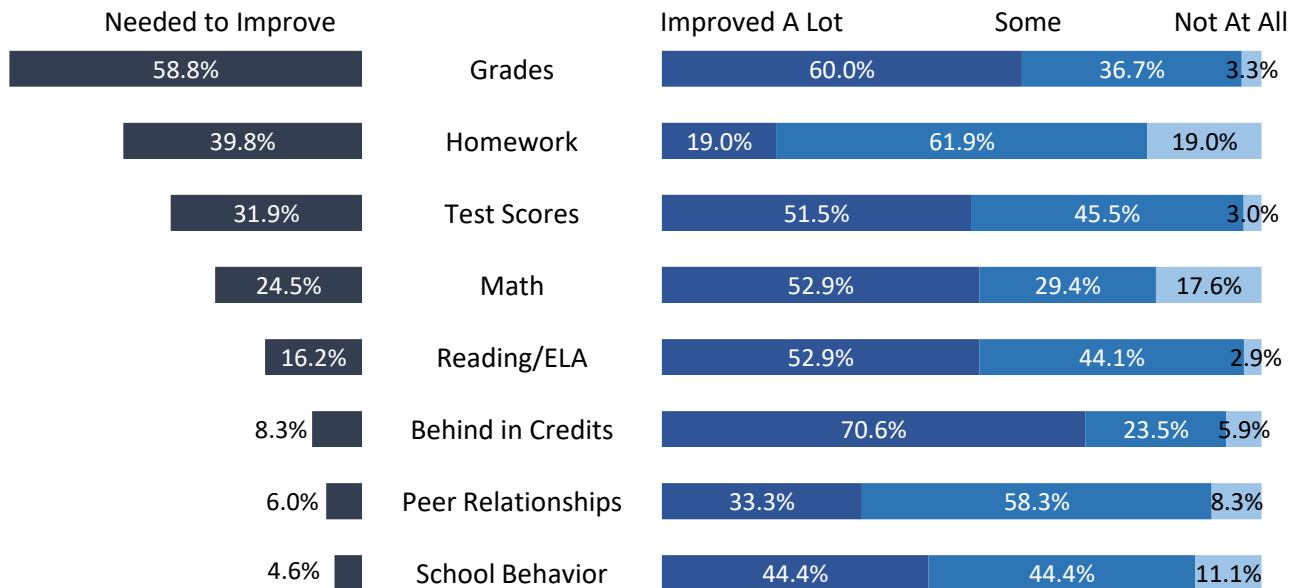
- 30** students requested *Sports/Physical and Outside Activity/Dance*

- 5** requested *Homework Help/Study Time/College Application Help*
- 5** requested *STEM/Robotics/Computer*

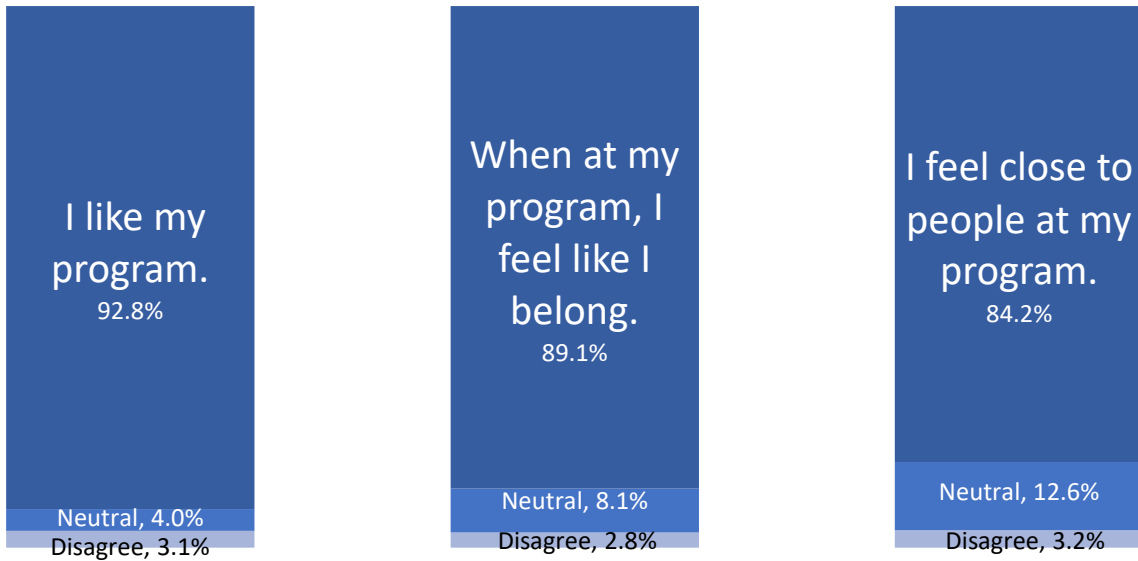

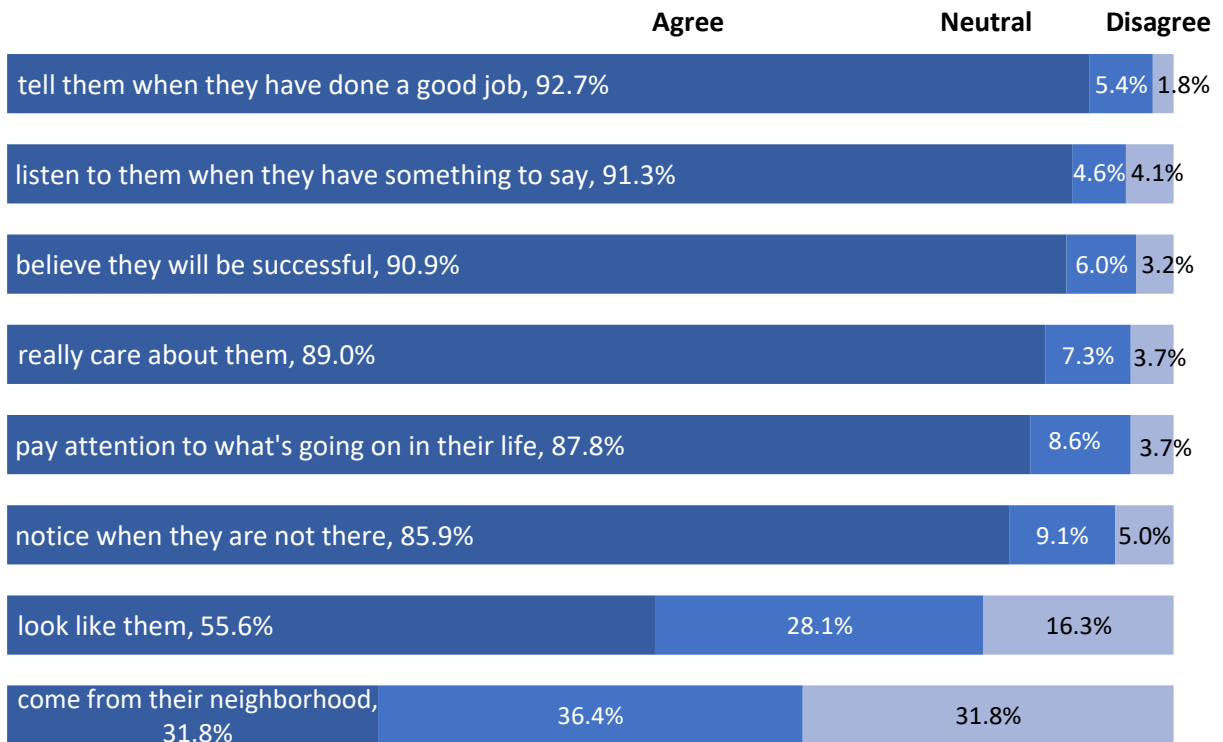
Students who said they needed to improve in the following areas then reported how much they felt they had improved during the school year⁴:
