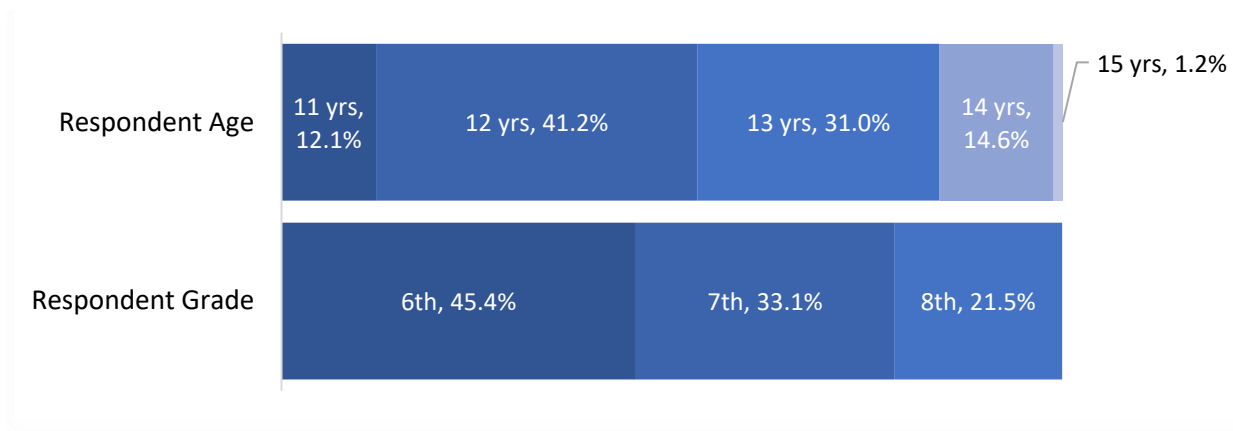

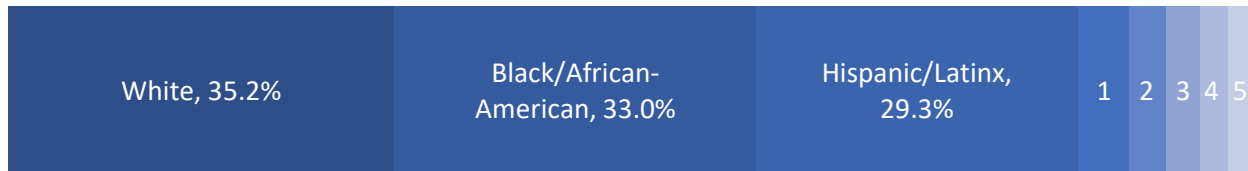

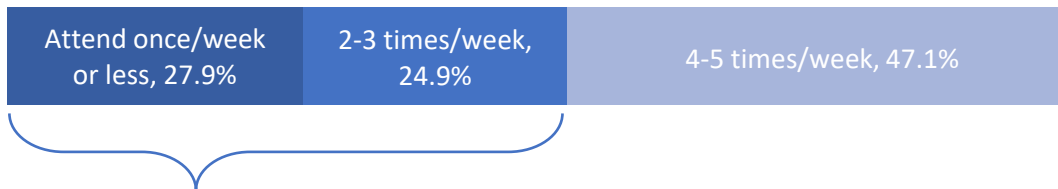

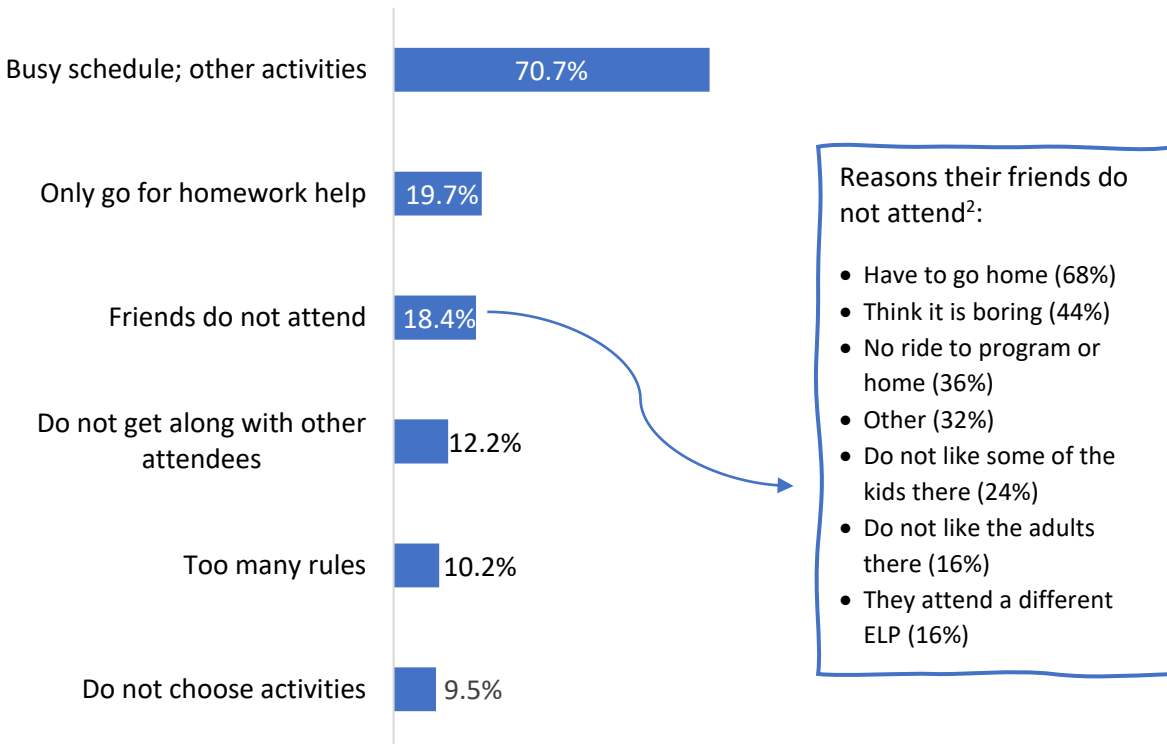

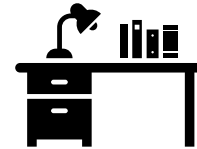
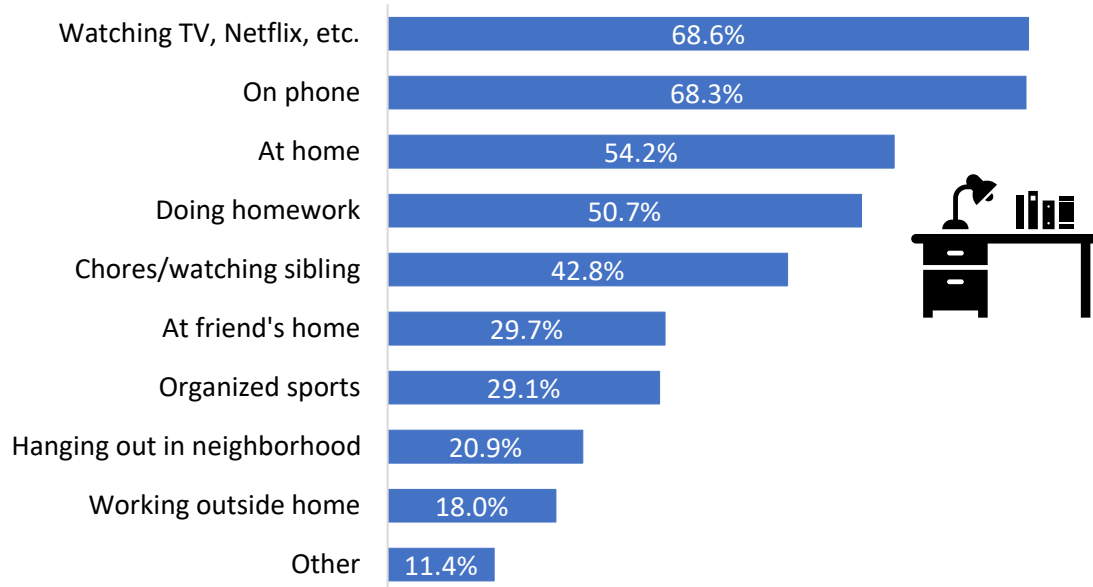
Attendance



Of the students who reported attending 3 times per week or less (52.8%), the following are reasons they do not attend more frequently²:

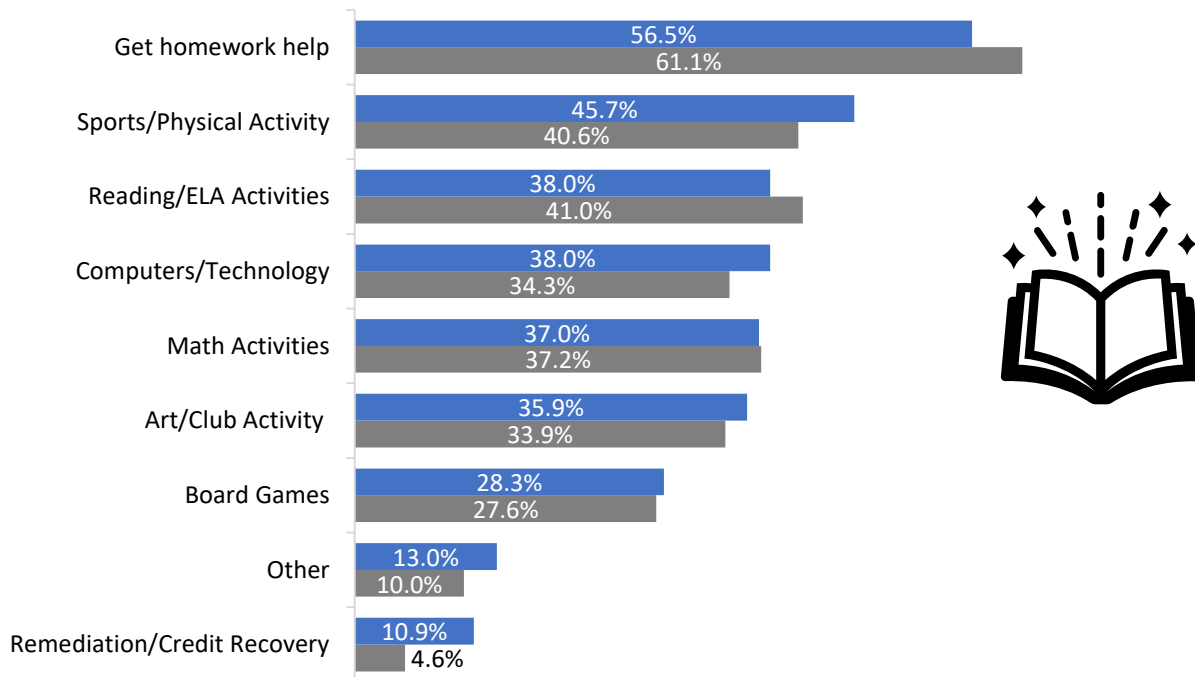


If not attending an ELP after school, students reported they would be doing the following activities^{1,3}:

Activities done at their ELP for those who attended *once a week or less* and who attended *at least twice a week*:²

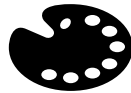

Students provided short-answer responses to the following question - **“If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?”**:

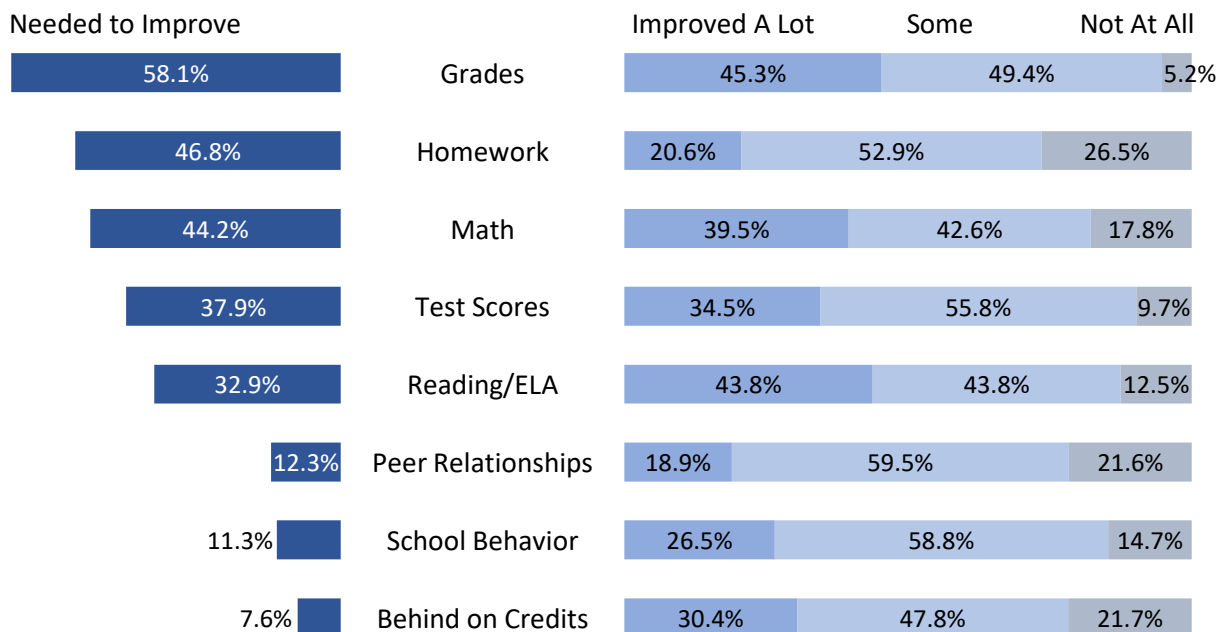
- 77** students requested *Sports/Physical Activity/Dance*
- 50** requested *Arts and Crafts*
- 31** requested *Outdoor Time/Activities*
- 25** requested *Studying/Tutoring/Homework*
- 18** requested *Games* (e.g., board games)
- 18** requested *STEM/Robotics*
- 16** requested *Free Time and/or Phone Time*
- 13** requested *Baking/Cooking*

Other activities mentioned: *Video Games/Gaming* (6), *Life Skills* (5), *Music/Band* (5), *Movie/TV time* (4), *Book Club* (4), *Mental Health* (4), *Relaxation/Nap* (3), *Field Trips* (3), *Drama* (1)

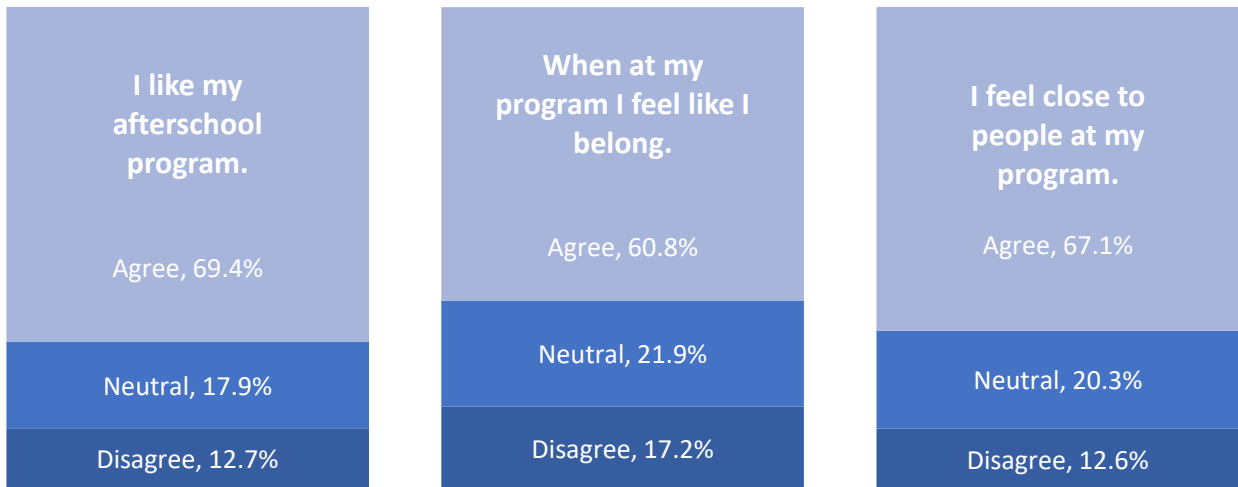


Student Perceptions
