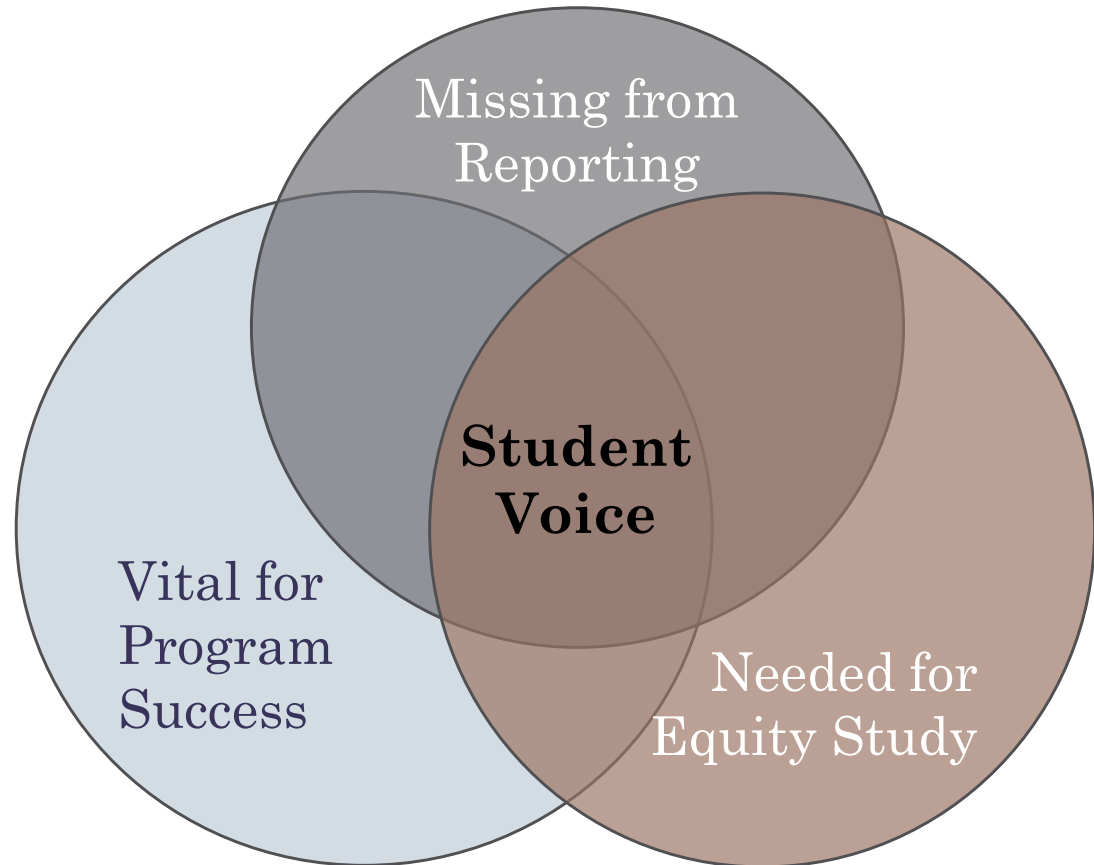

What is the Student Survey?

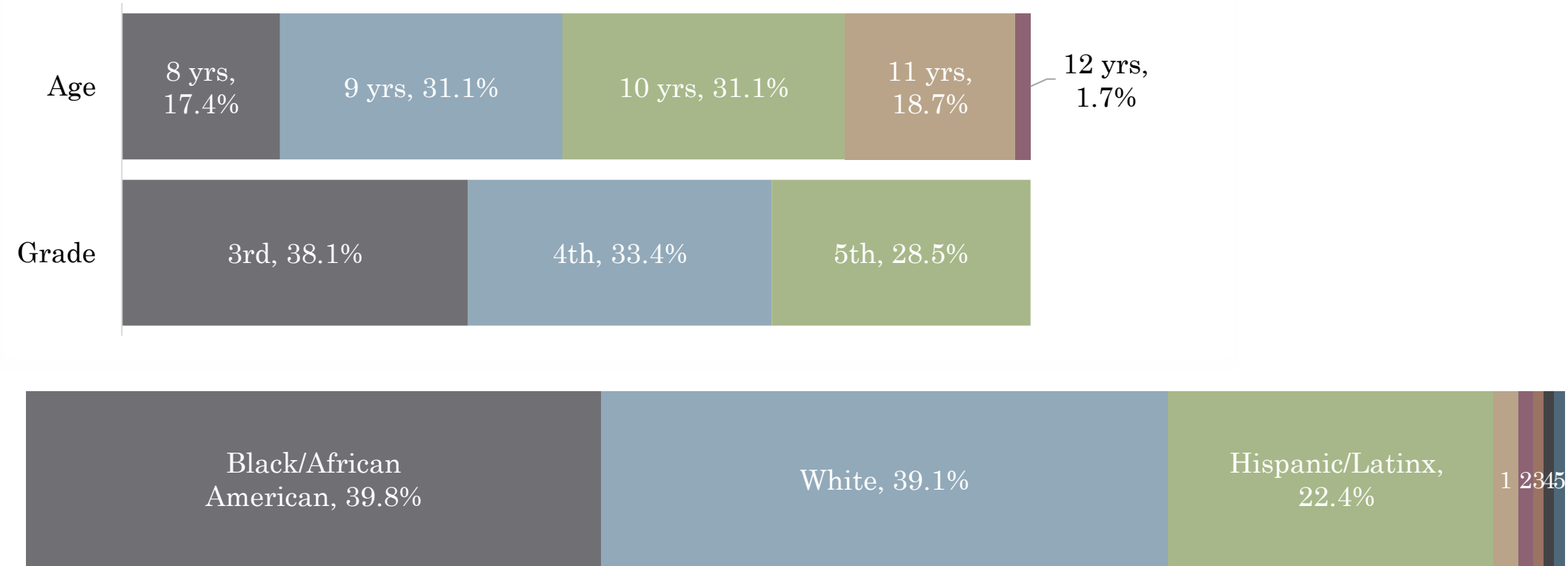
- Sample of 50 sites
- Two versions:
 - Elementary (9 questions)
 - Middle/High School (26 questions)
- Open from Late March – May 31st
- Target: 50% completion per site



887 Total Completes – 43.3%

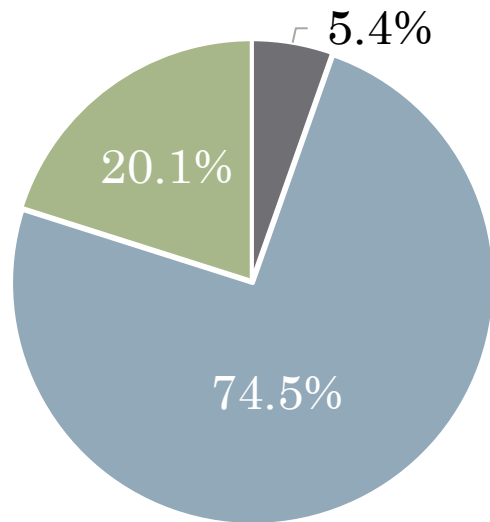

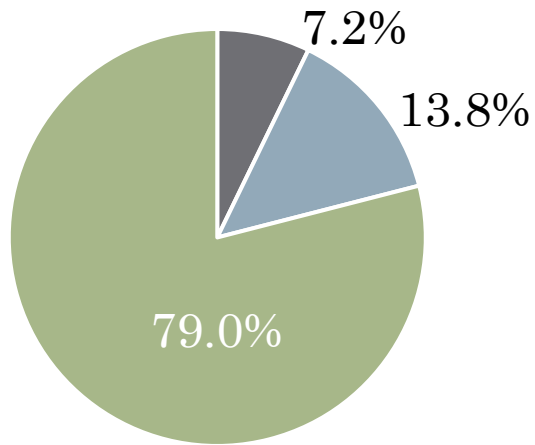

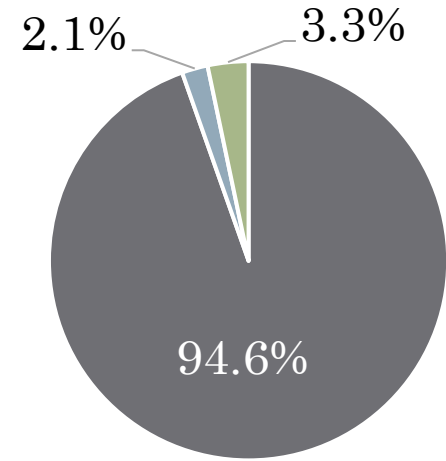

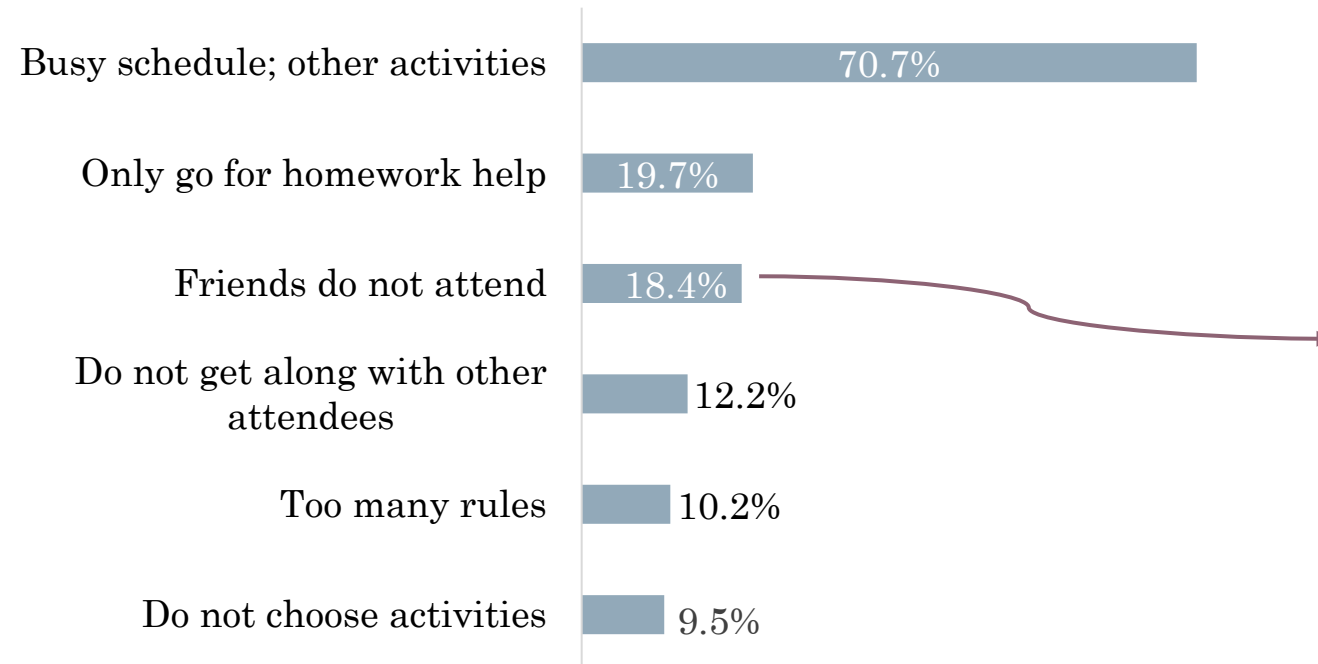

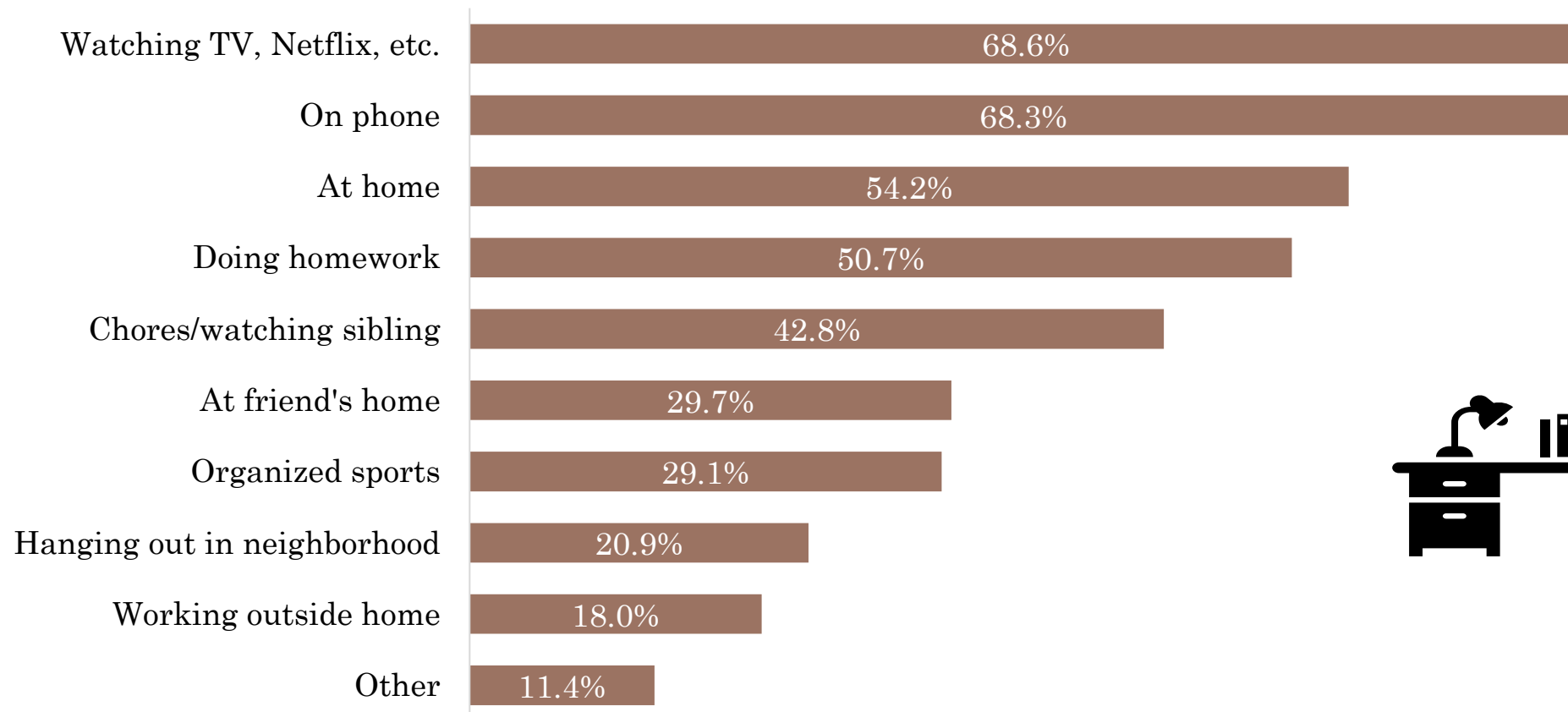

Reasons their friends do not attend:

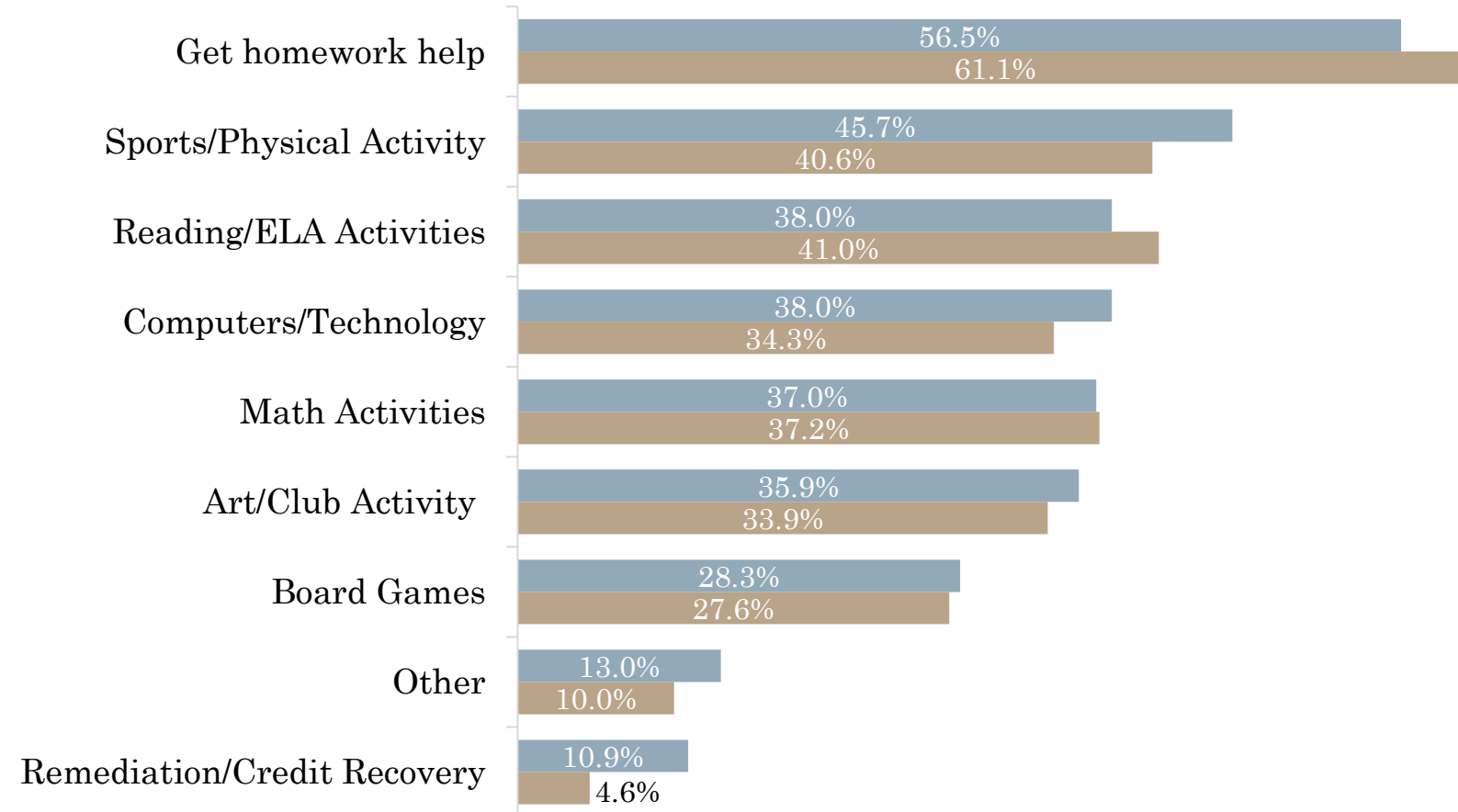
- Have to go home (68%)

- Other (32%)

If not attending an ELP after school, students reported they would be doing the following activities:



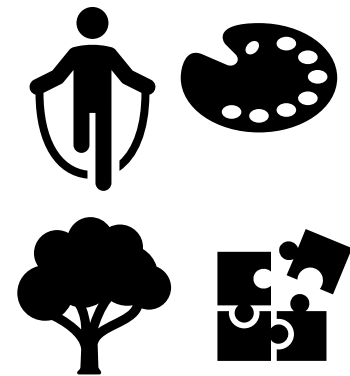

Activities done at ELP for those who attended *once a week or less* and who attended *at least twice a week*:

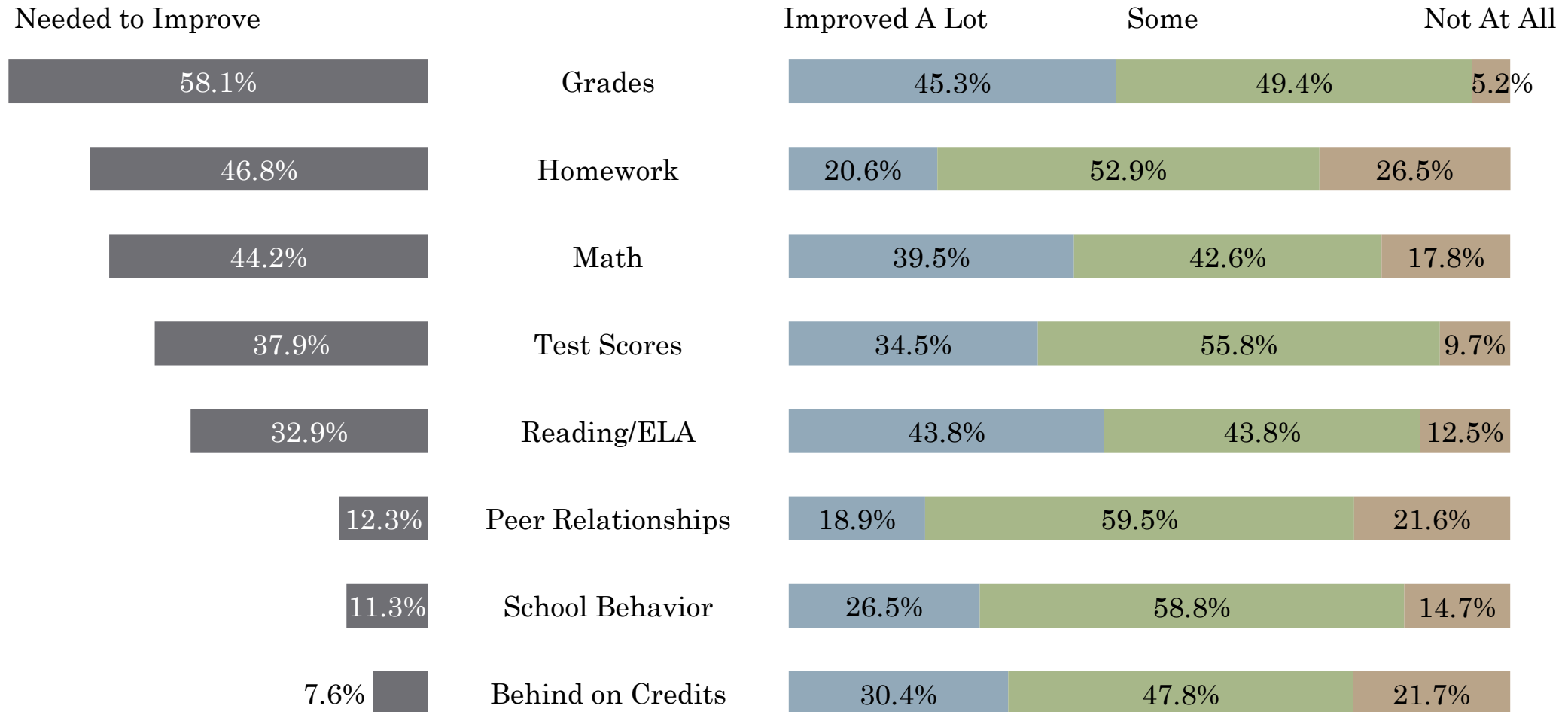


“If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?”:

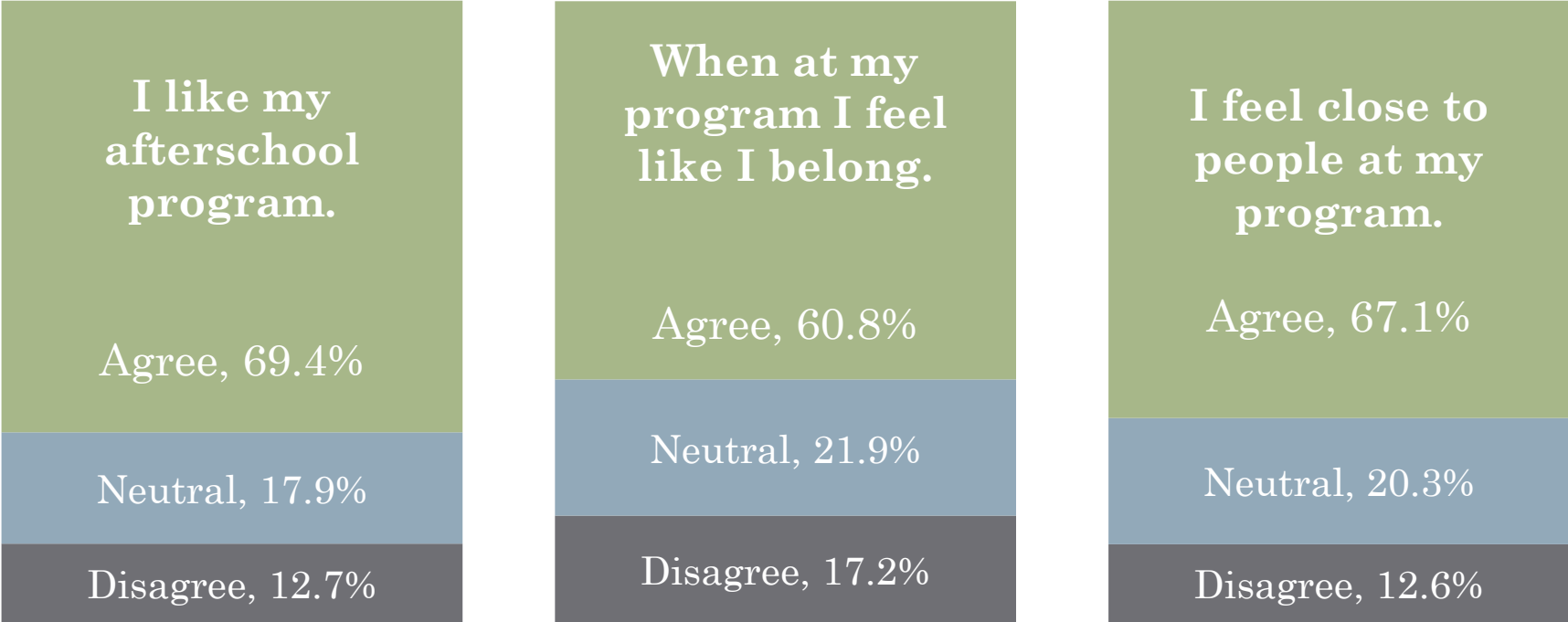
- **77** students requested *Sports/Physical Activity/Dance*

- **18** requested *STEM/Robotics*
- **16** requested *Free Time and/or Phone Time*
- **13** requested *Baking/Cooking*



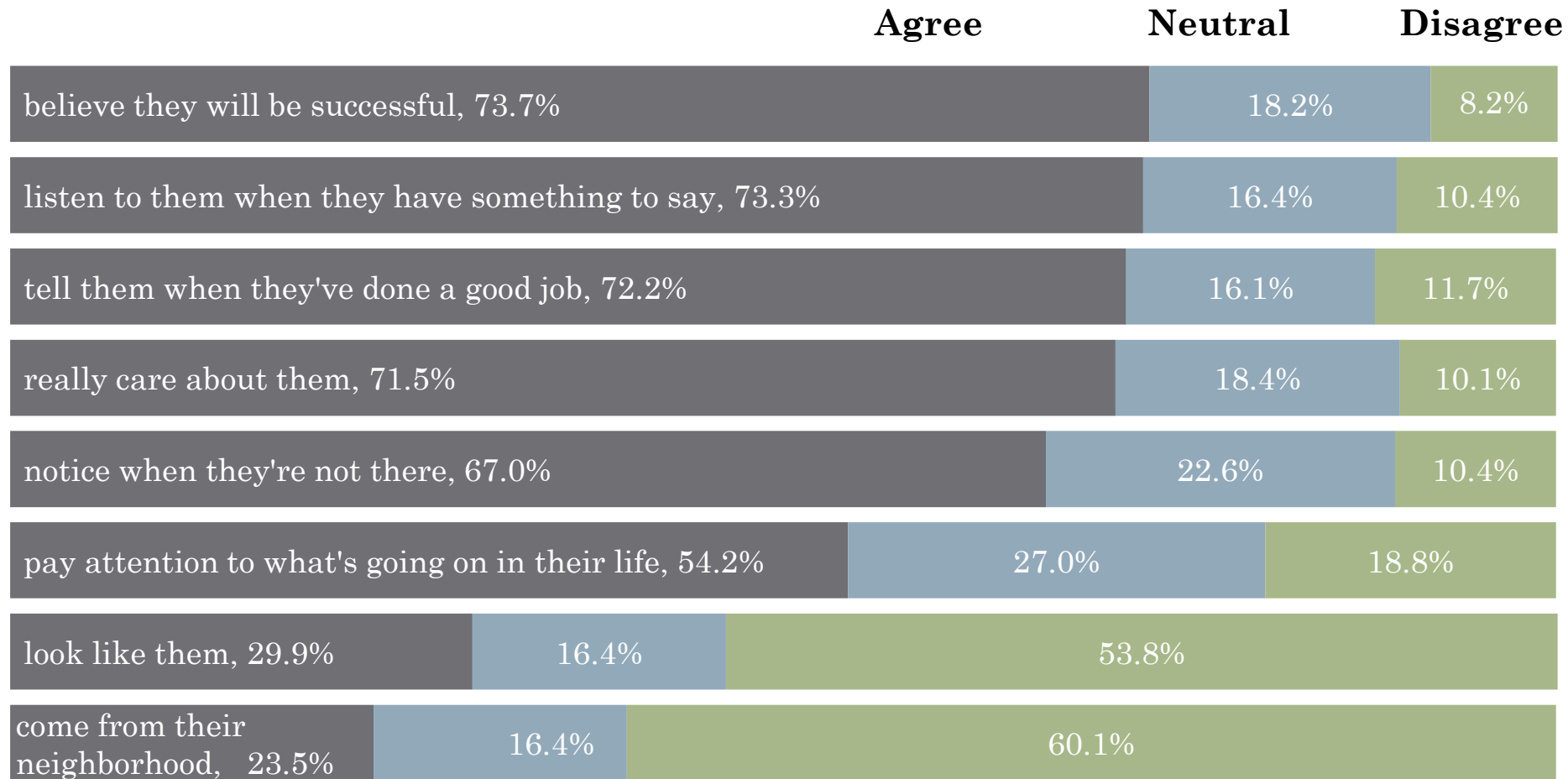

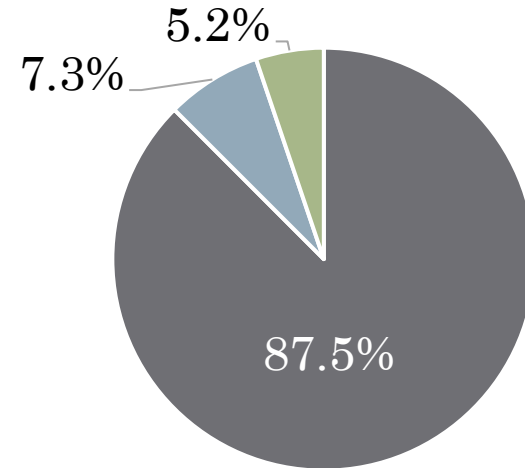
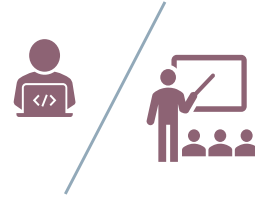


1 – Multiracial (3.1%); 2 – Hispanic/Latinx (2.7%); 3 – Asian American (1.4%);

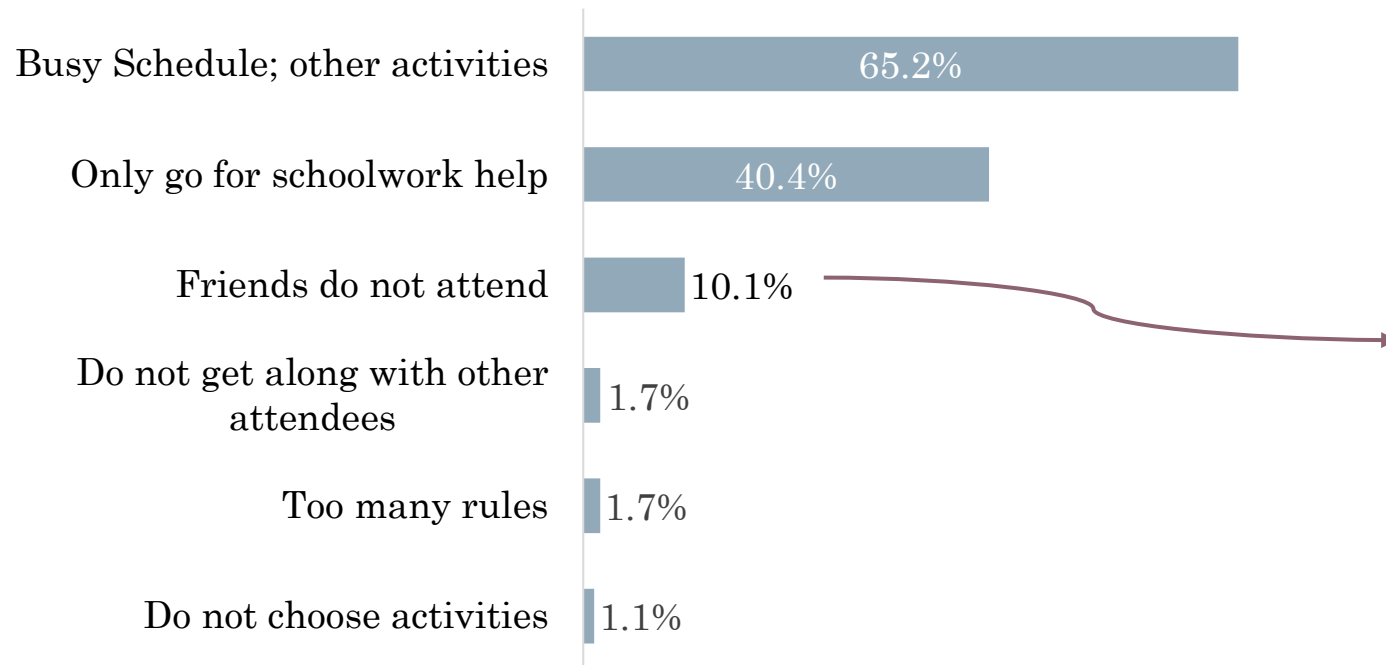

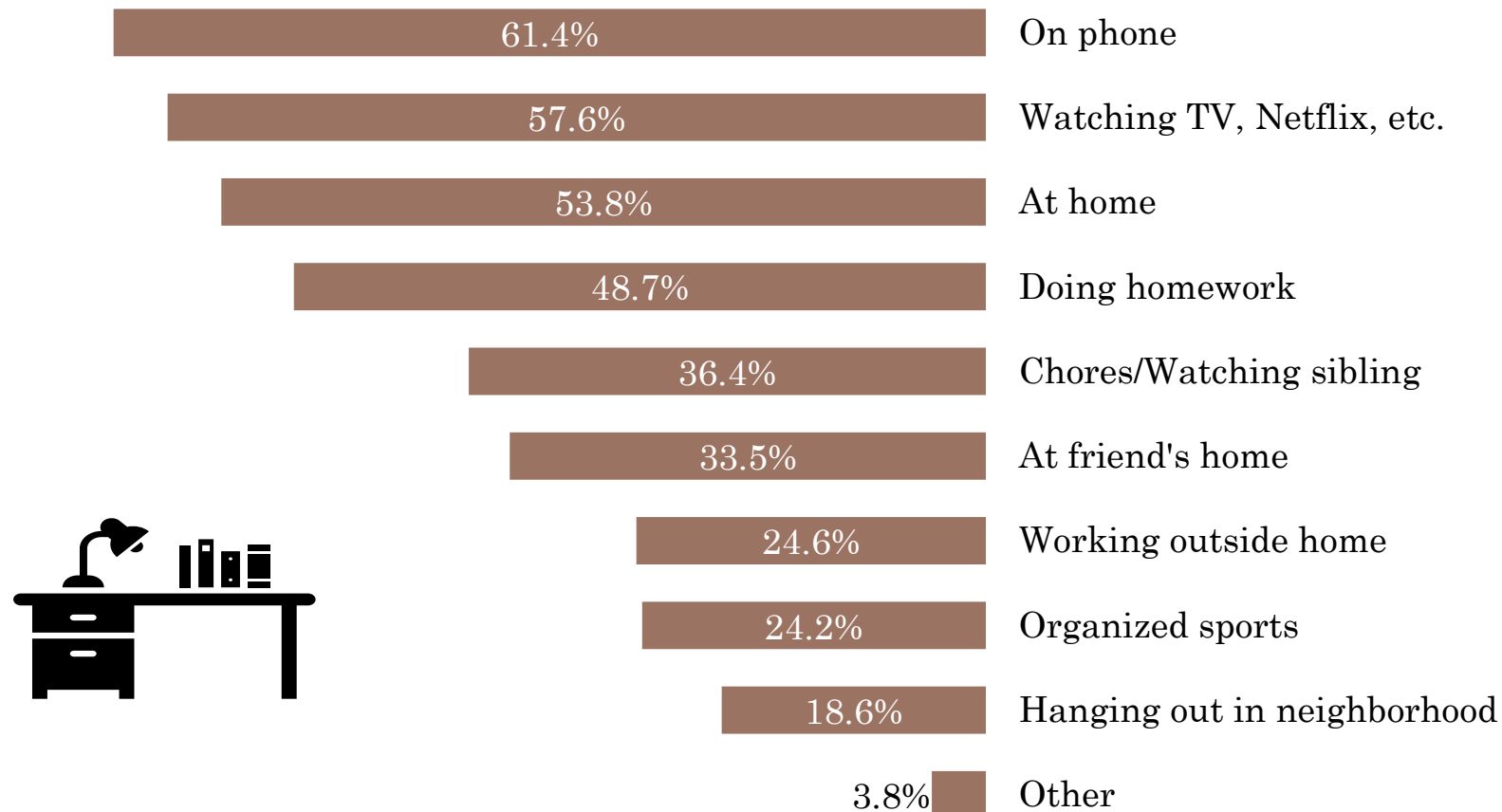

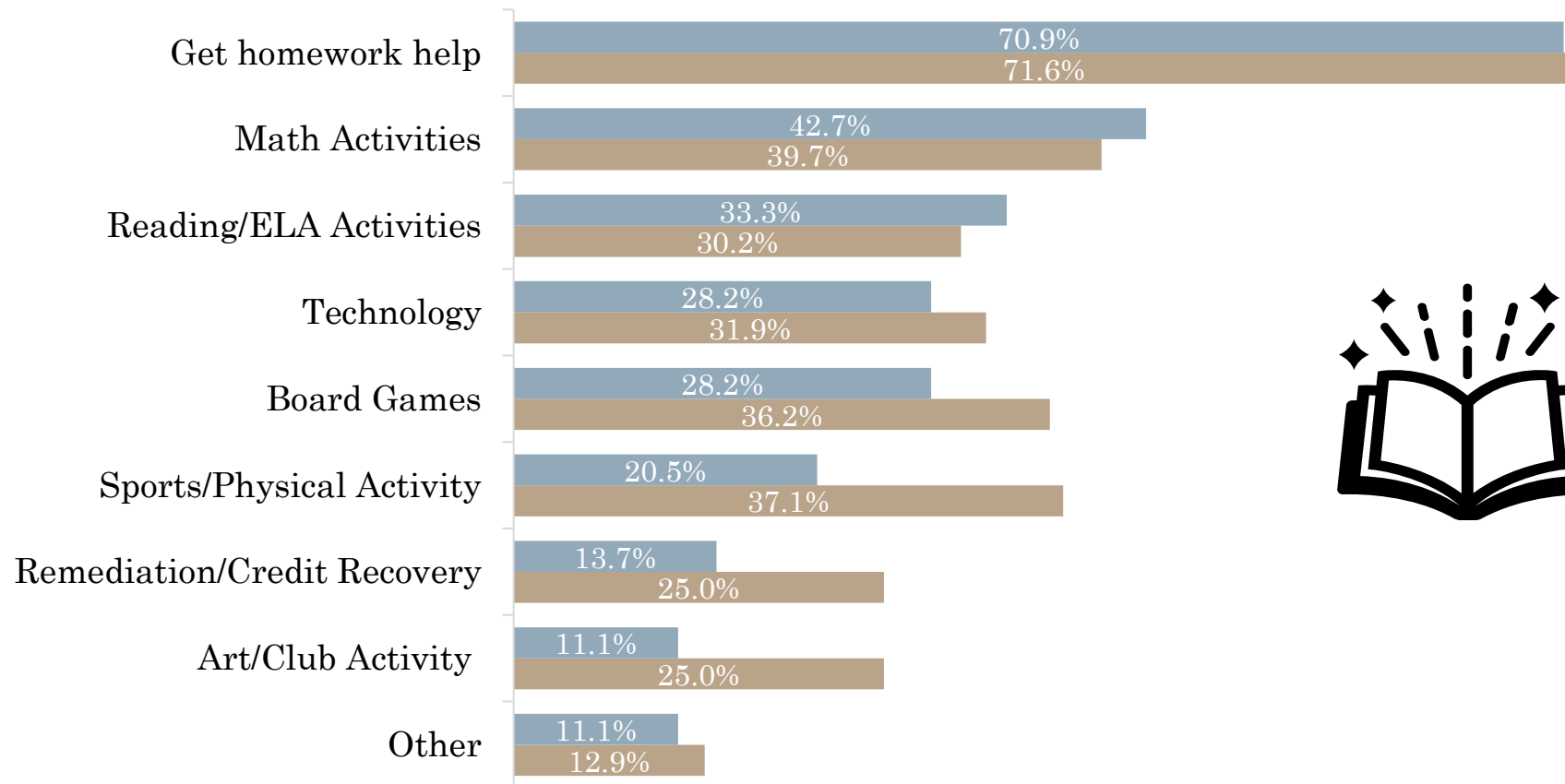
- Reasons their friends do not attend:

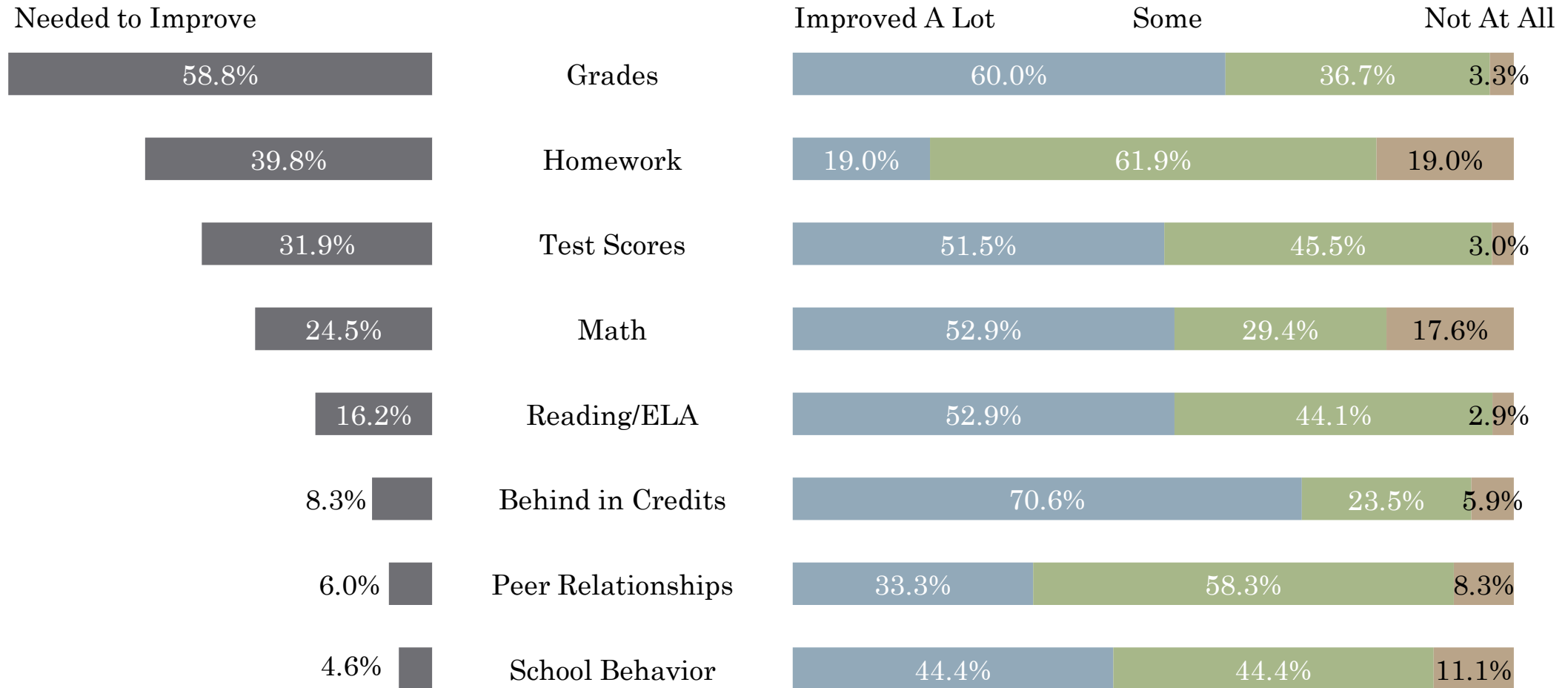

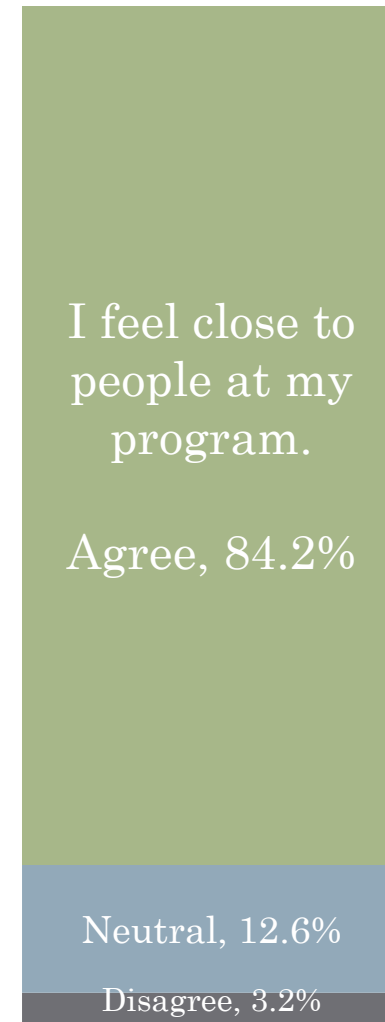
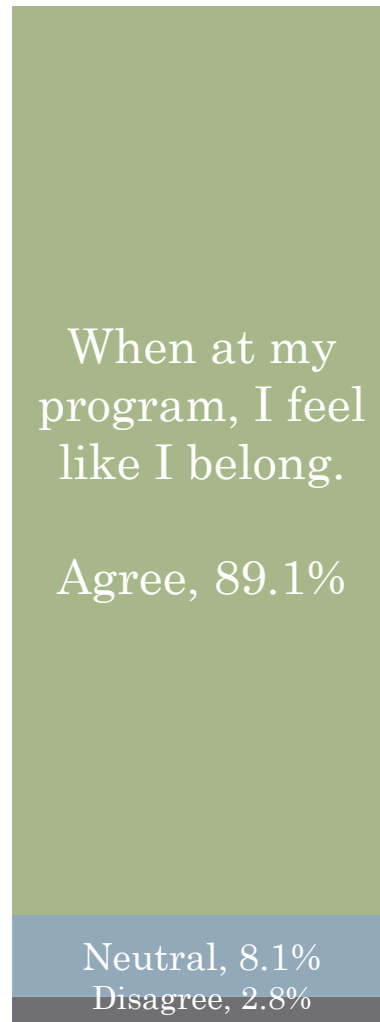
- 30 students requested *Sports/Physical and Outside Activity/Dance*

- 5 requested *STEM/Robotics/Computer*



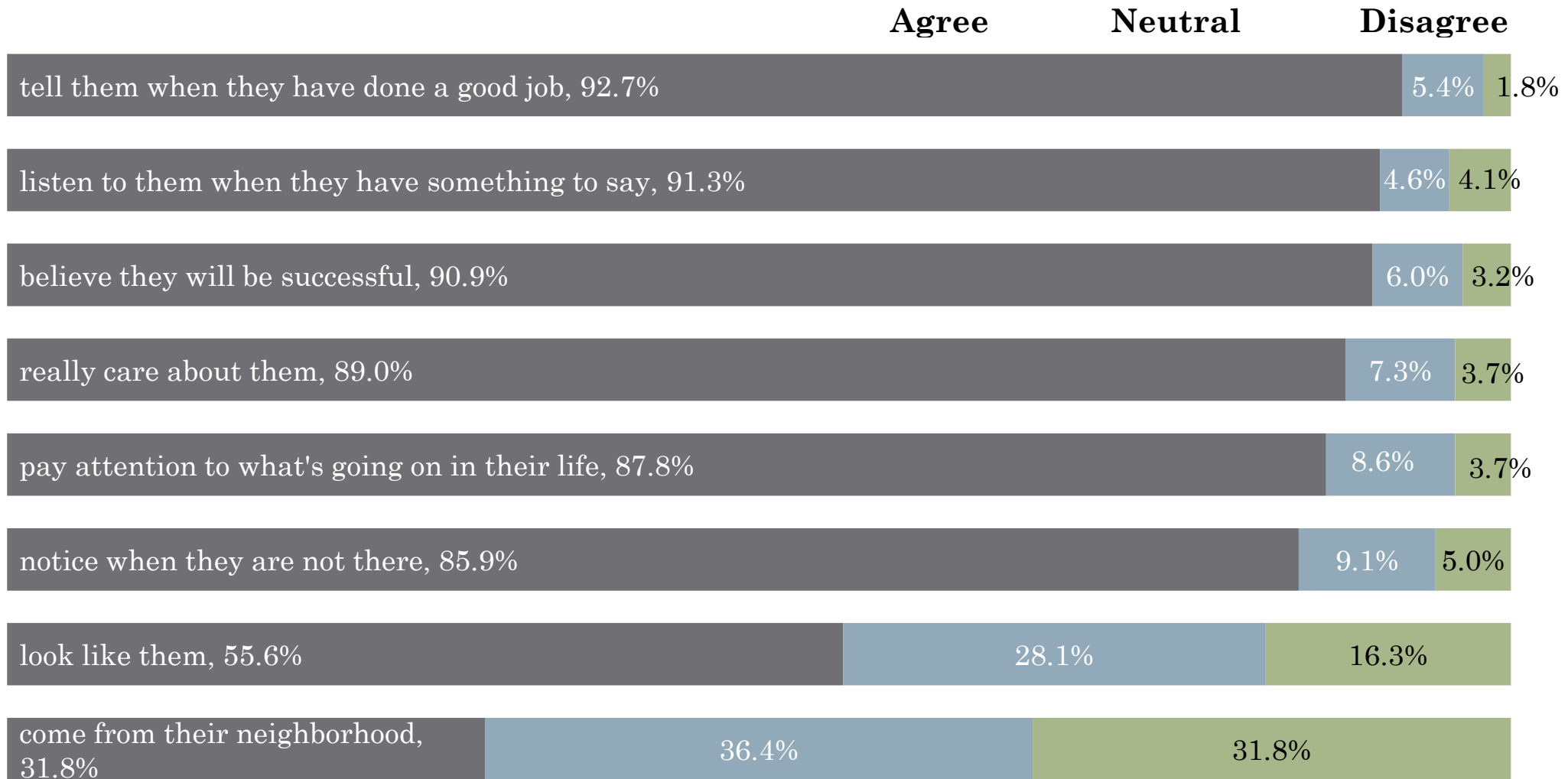

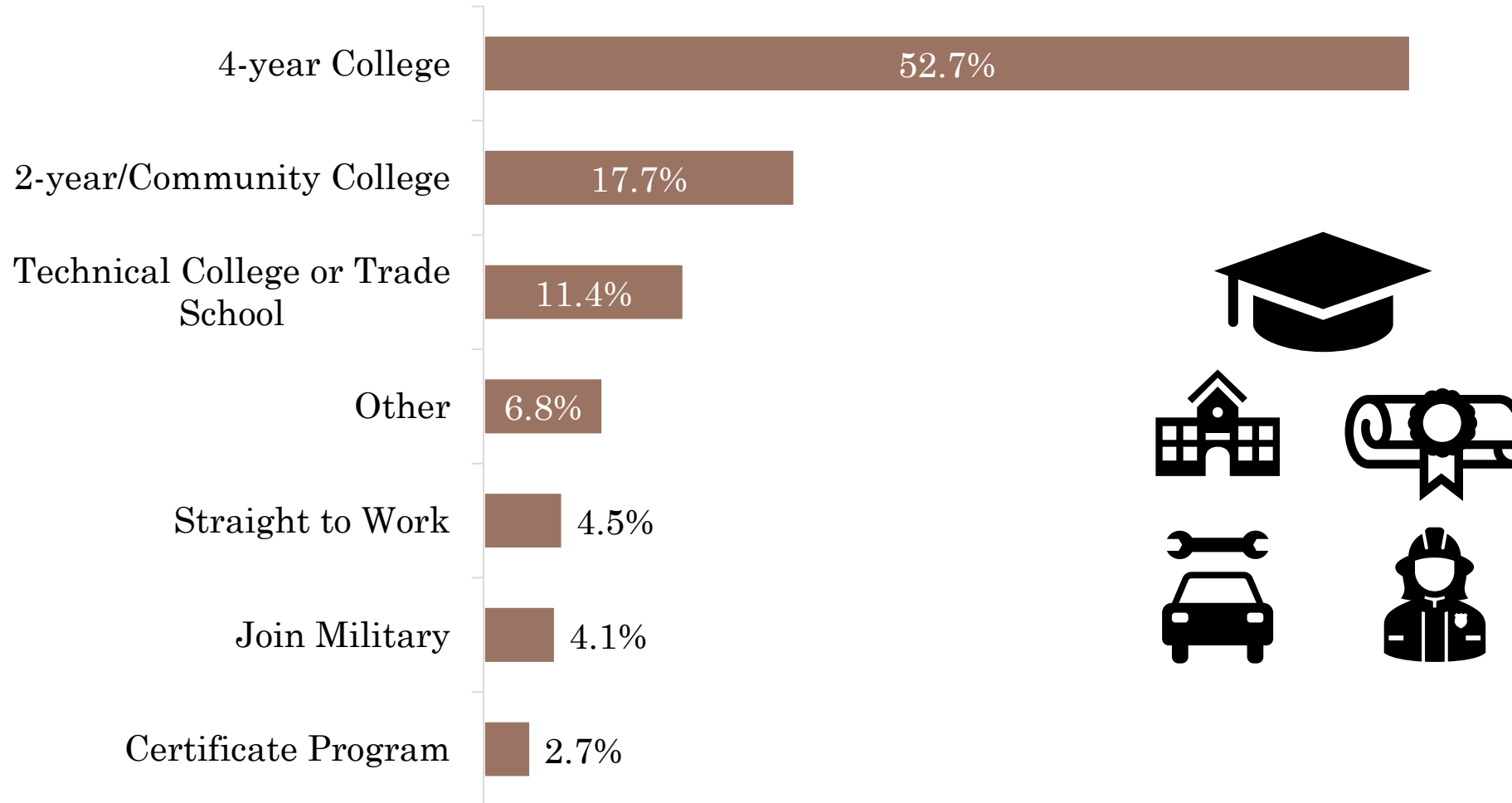
