

What is the Student Survey?


- Sample of 50 sites
- Two versions:
 - Elementary (9 questions)
 - Middle/High School (26 questions)
- Open from Late March May 31st
- Target: 50% completion per site



887 Total Completes – 43.3%

302 Completes - 53.6%	335 Completes $-42.7%$	$250~\mathrm{Completes} - 35.6\%$


Elementary School Findings









Activities done at ELP for those who attended *once a week or less* and who attended *at least twice a week*:




"If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?":




