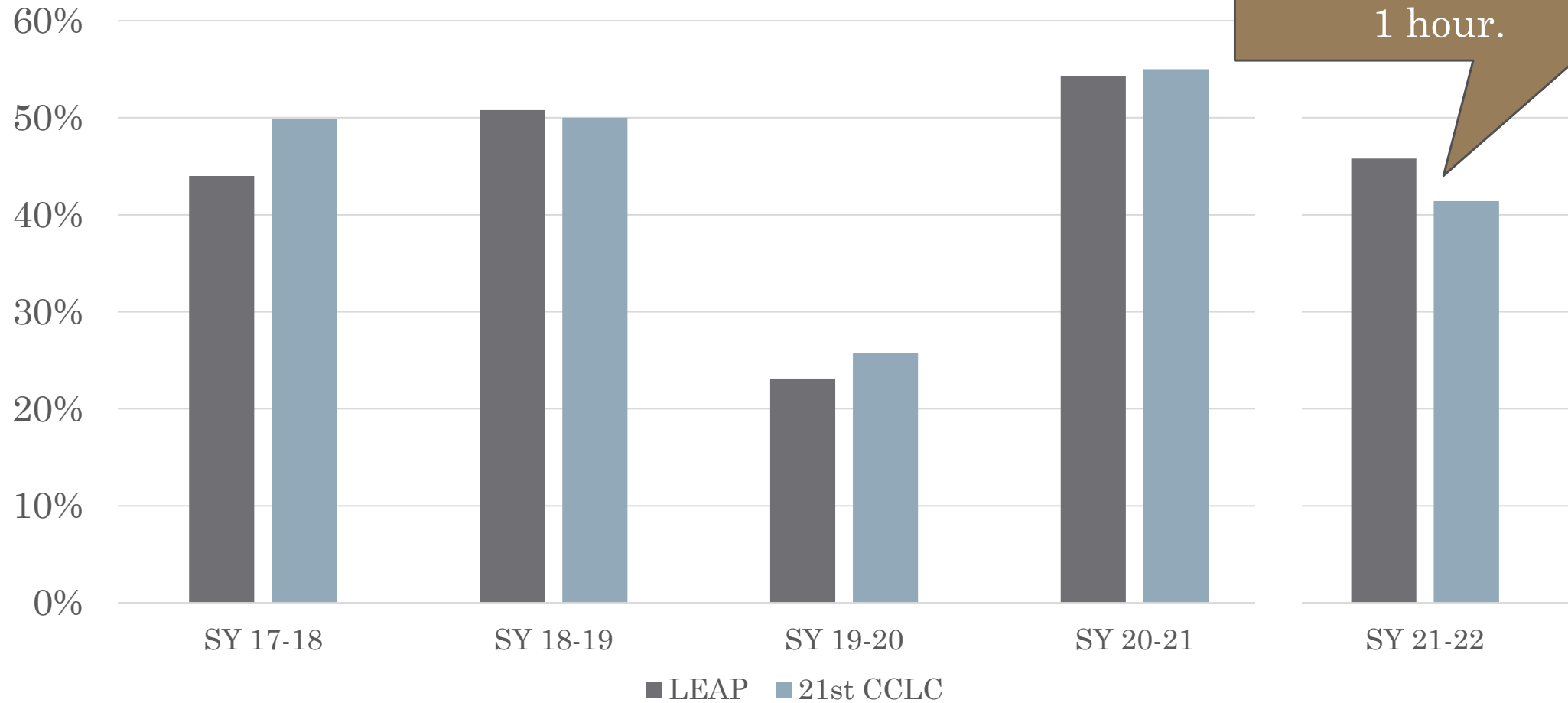

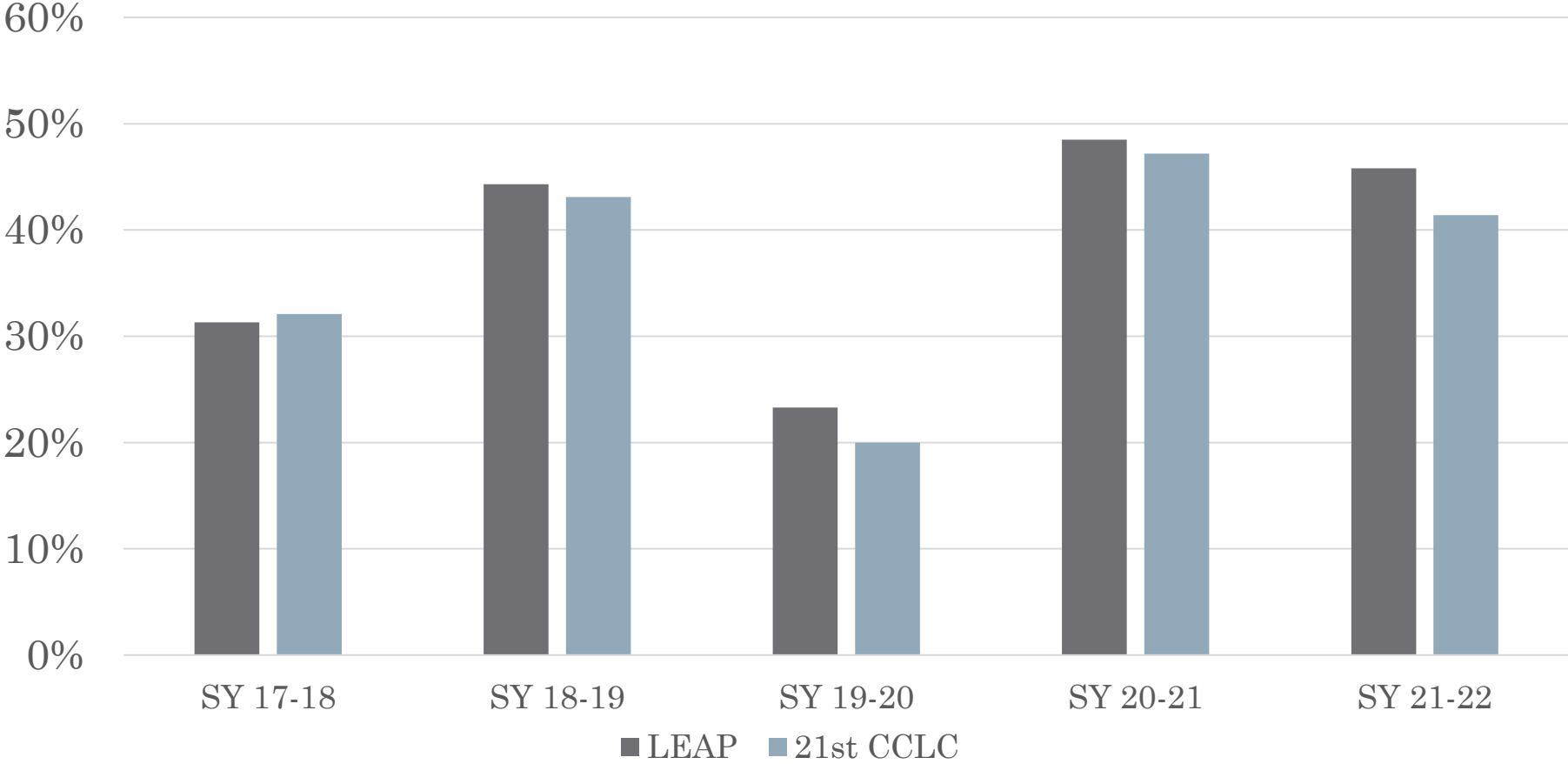

Last year, Teachers completed surveys for 42.8% of those who attended a program for at least 1 hour.

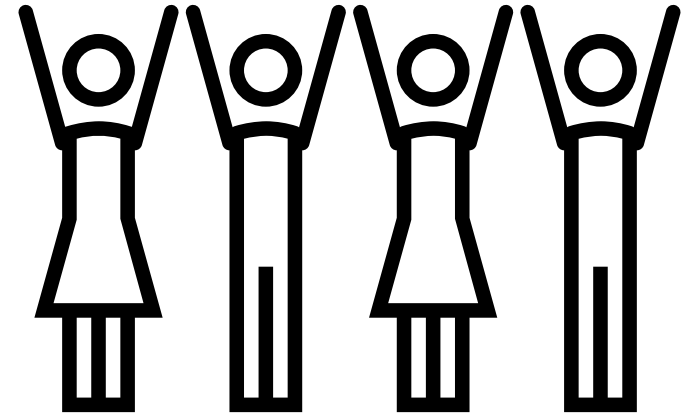


Response Rates – 1+ Hours



2021-2022 Findings

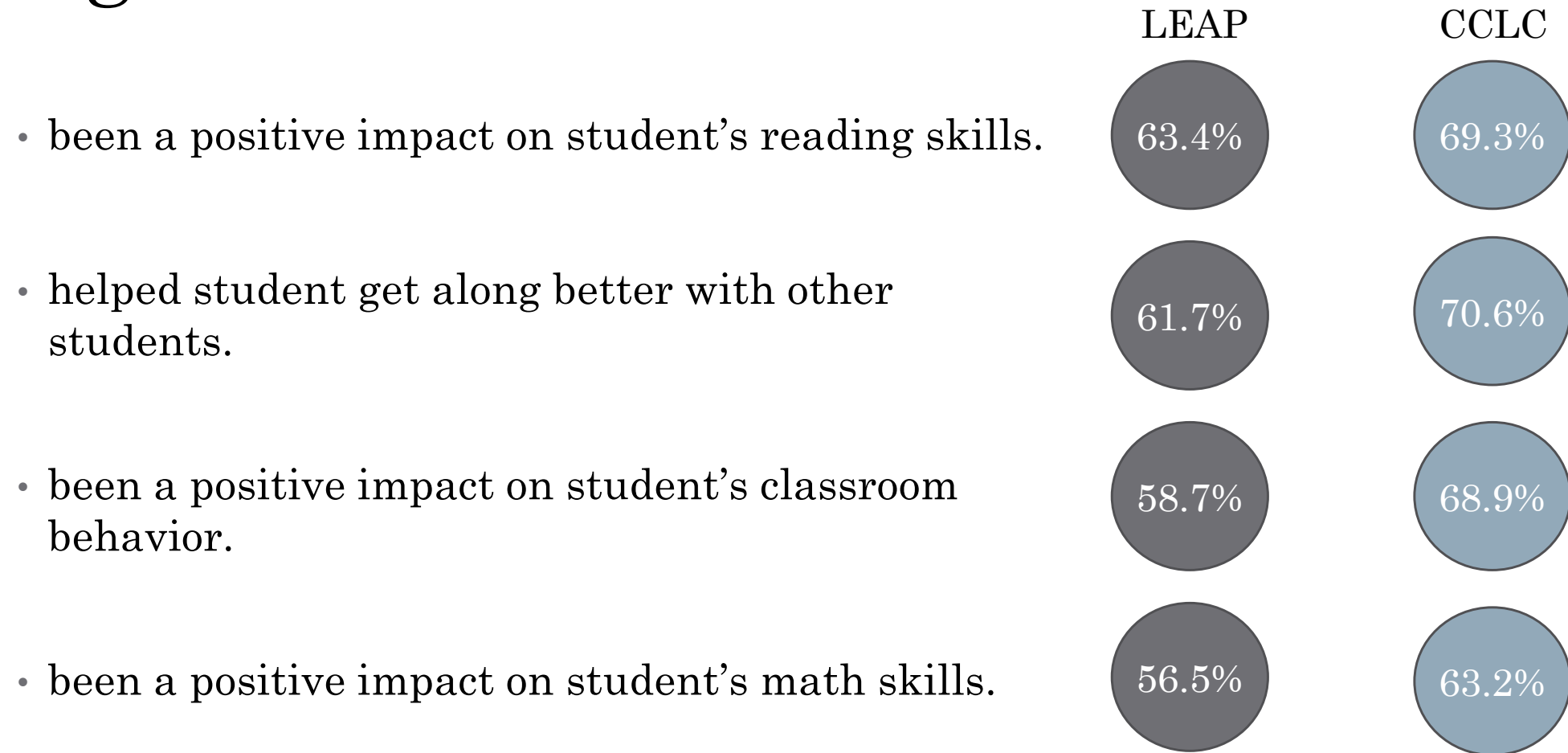
- 6 out of 10 teachers think the program has benefitted the student a lot or a great deal.
- 7 out of 10 teachers are very or extremely satisfied with the communication they receive from the ELP.



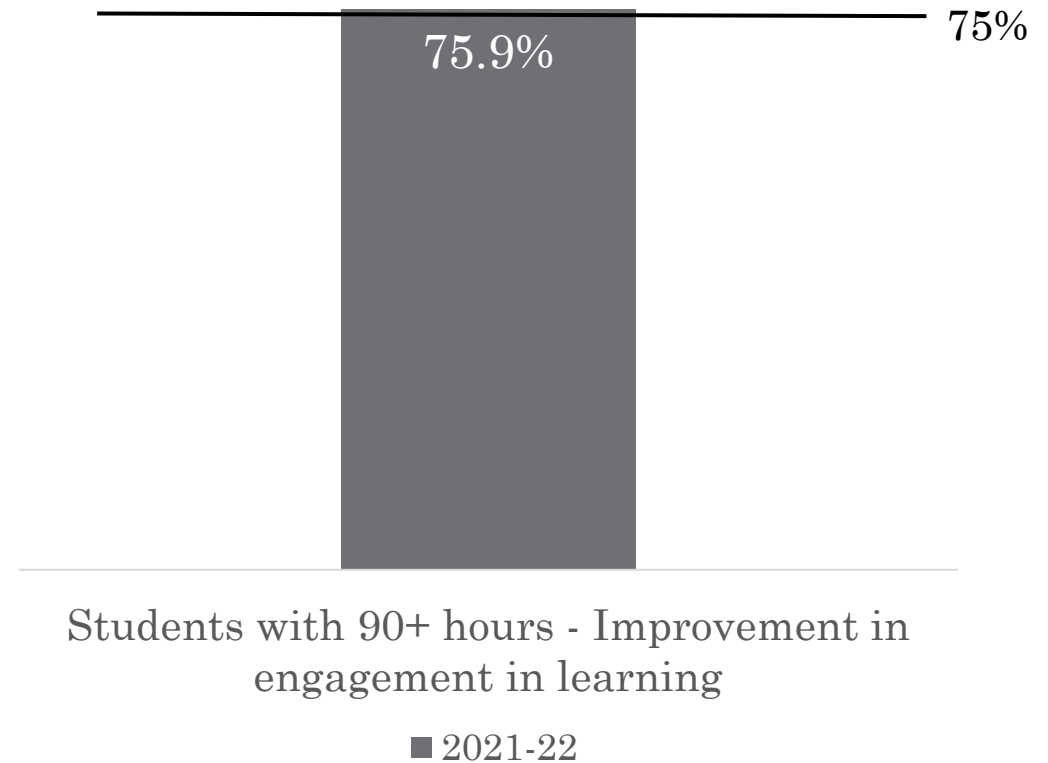
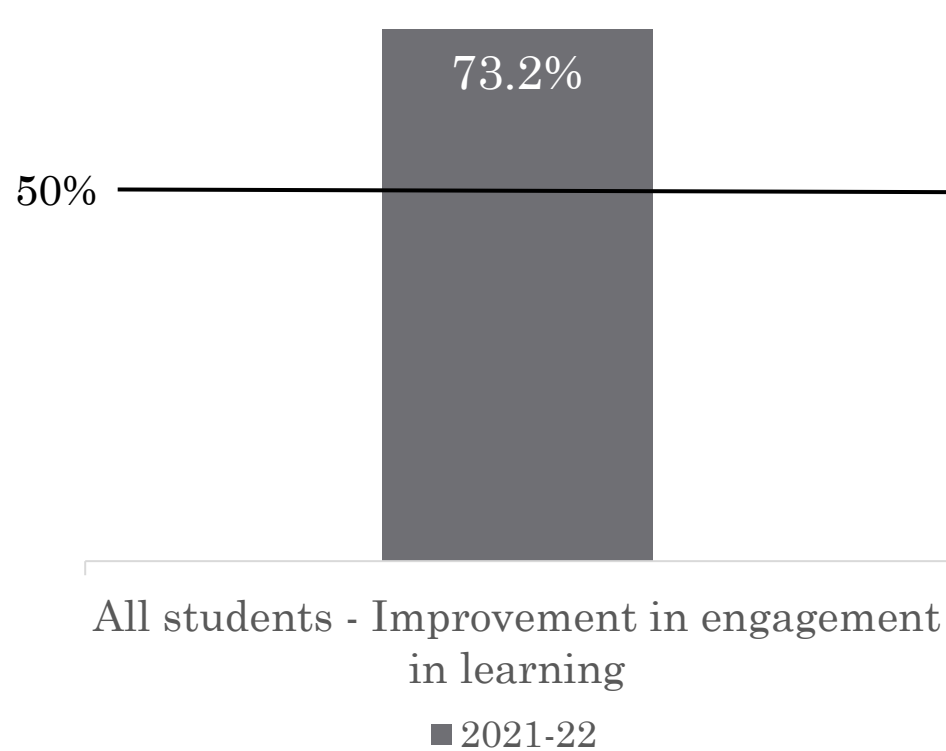
Teachers who Agree or Strongly Agree the ELP has:

• helped improve student's level of class participation.	66.4%	74.3%

• helped student complete homework assignments in a more timely manner.	64.2%	73.8%

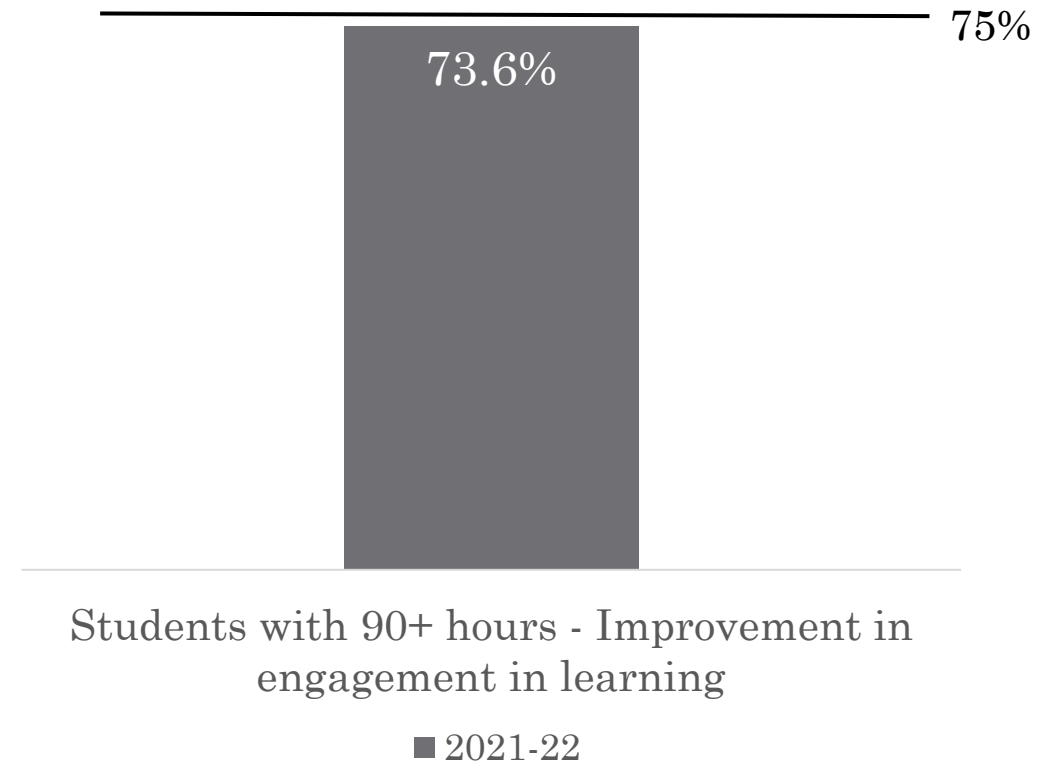
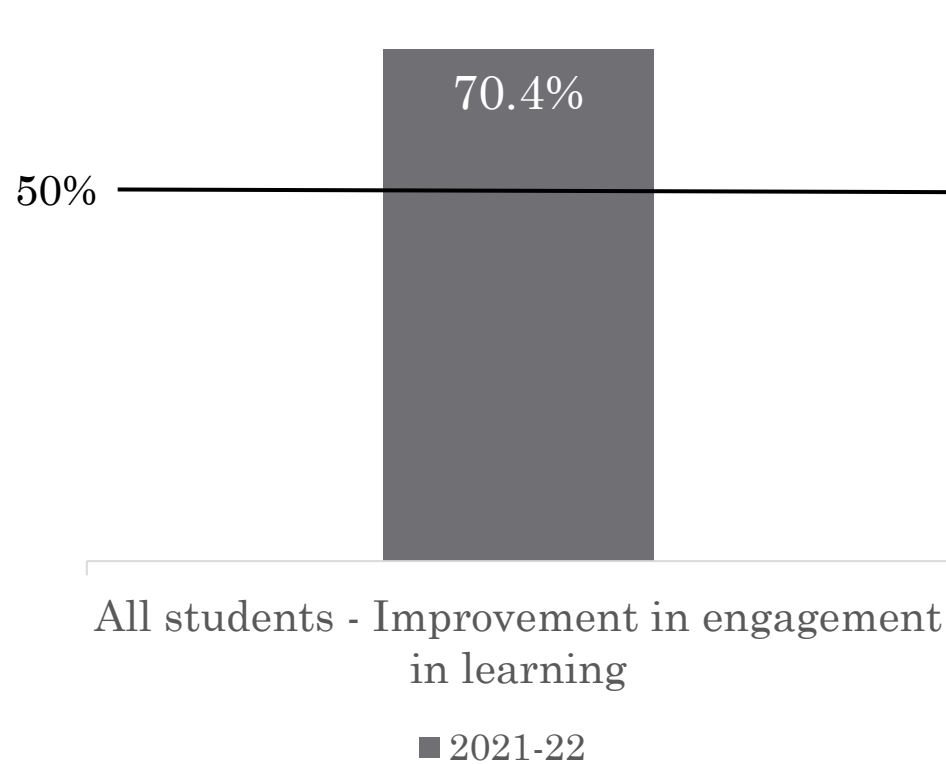
