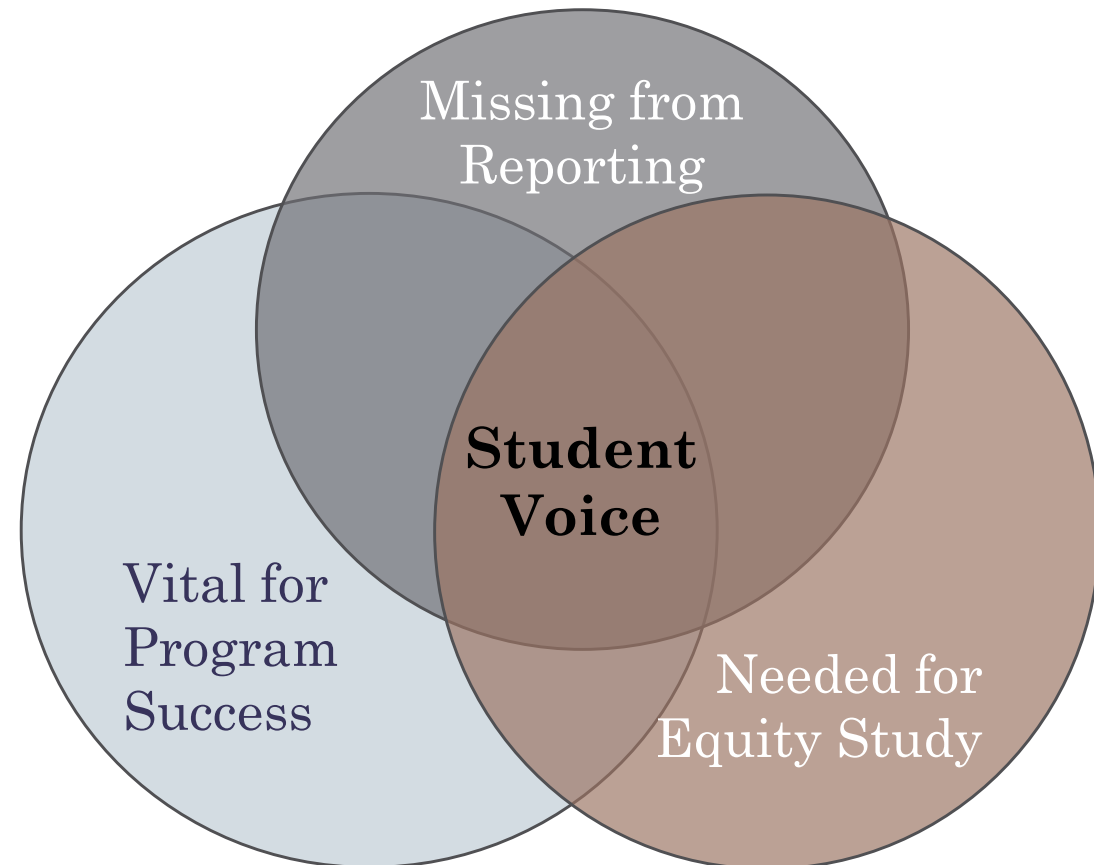

# What is the Student Survey?

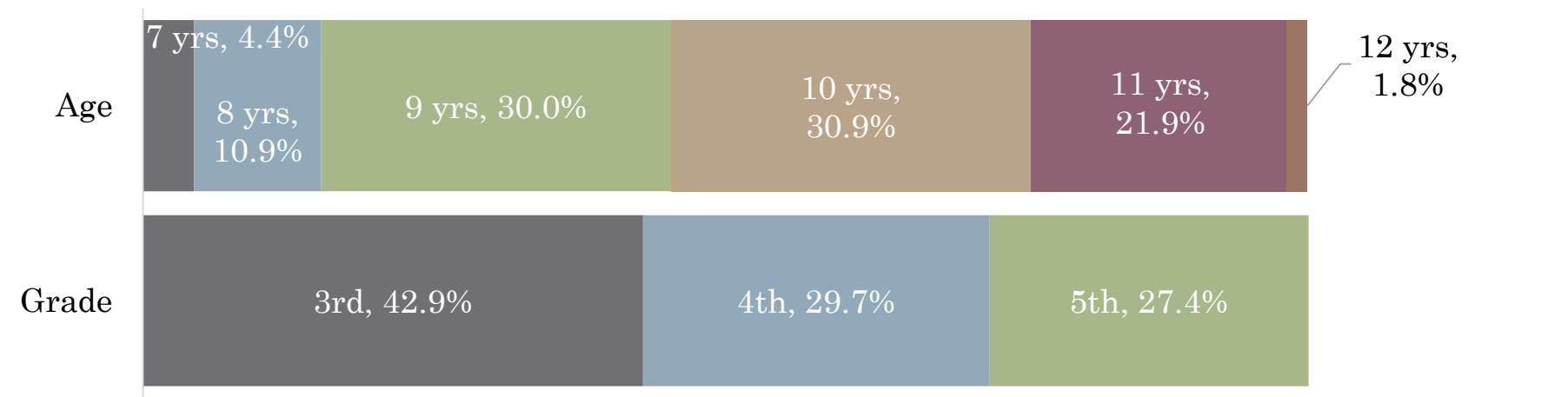
- Sample of 50 sites
- Two versions:
  - Elementary (9 questions)
  - Middle/High School (26 questions)
- Open from Late March – May 31<sup>st</sup>
- Target: 50% completion per site



# 1,258 Total Completes – 29.7%

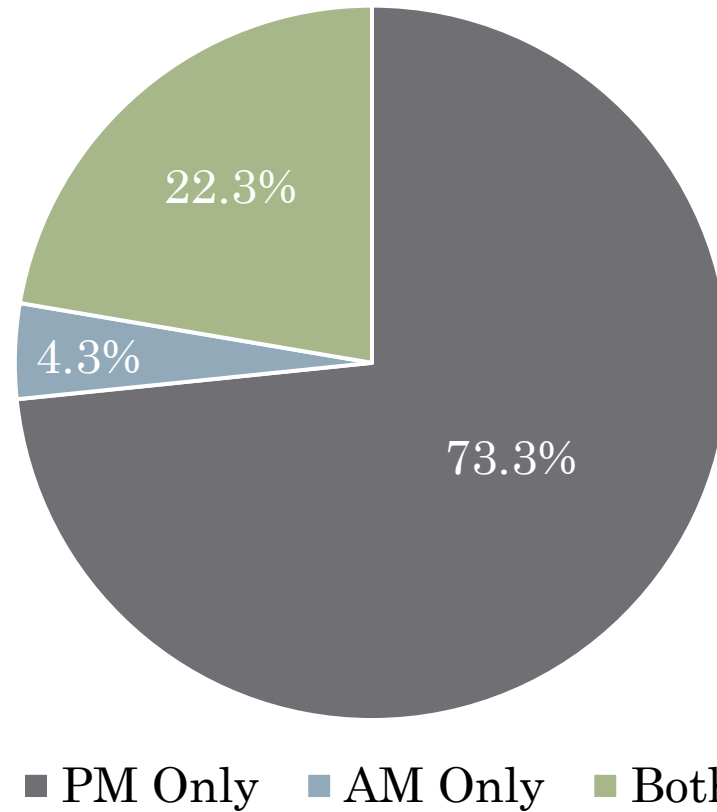

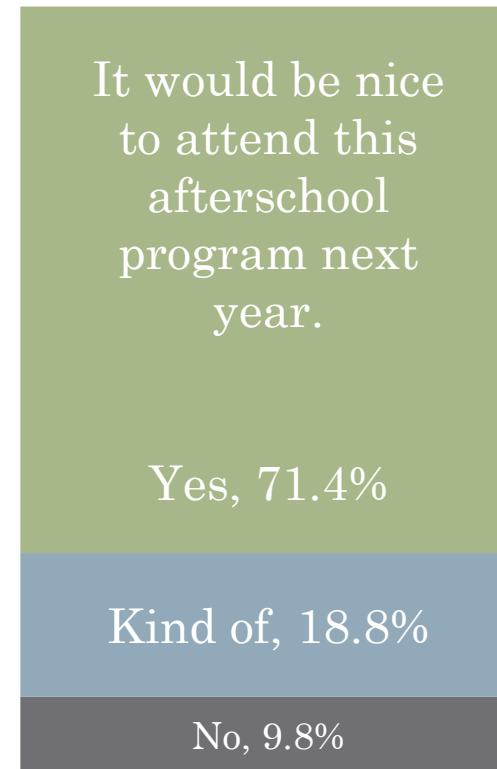
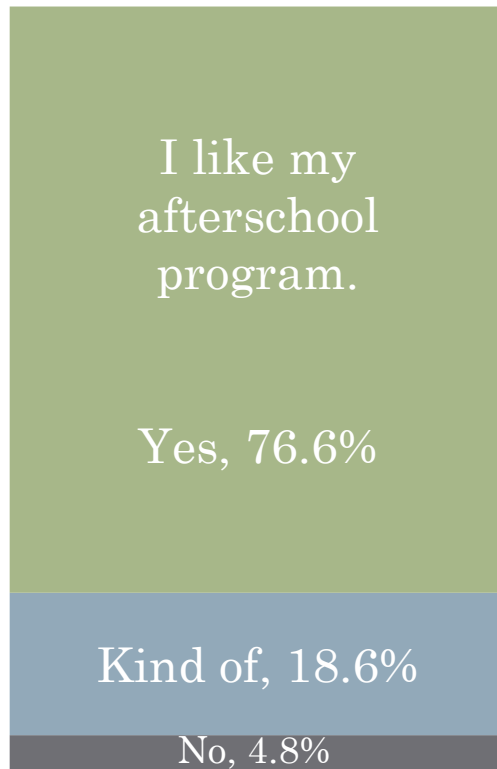

 5 – Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, 0.2%

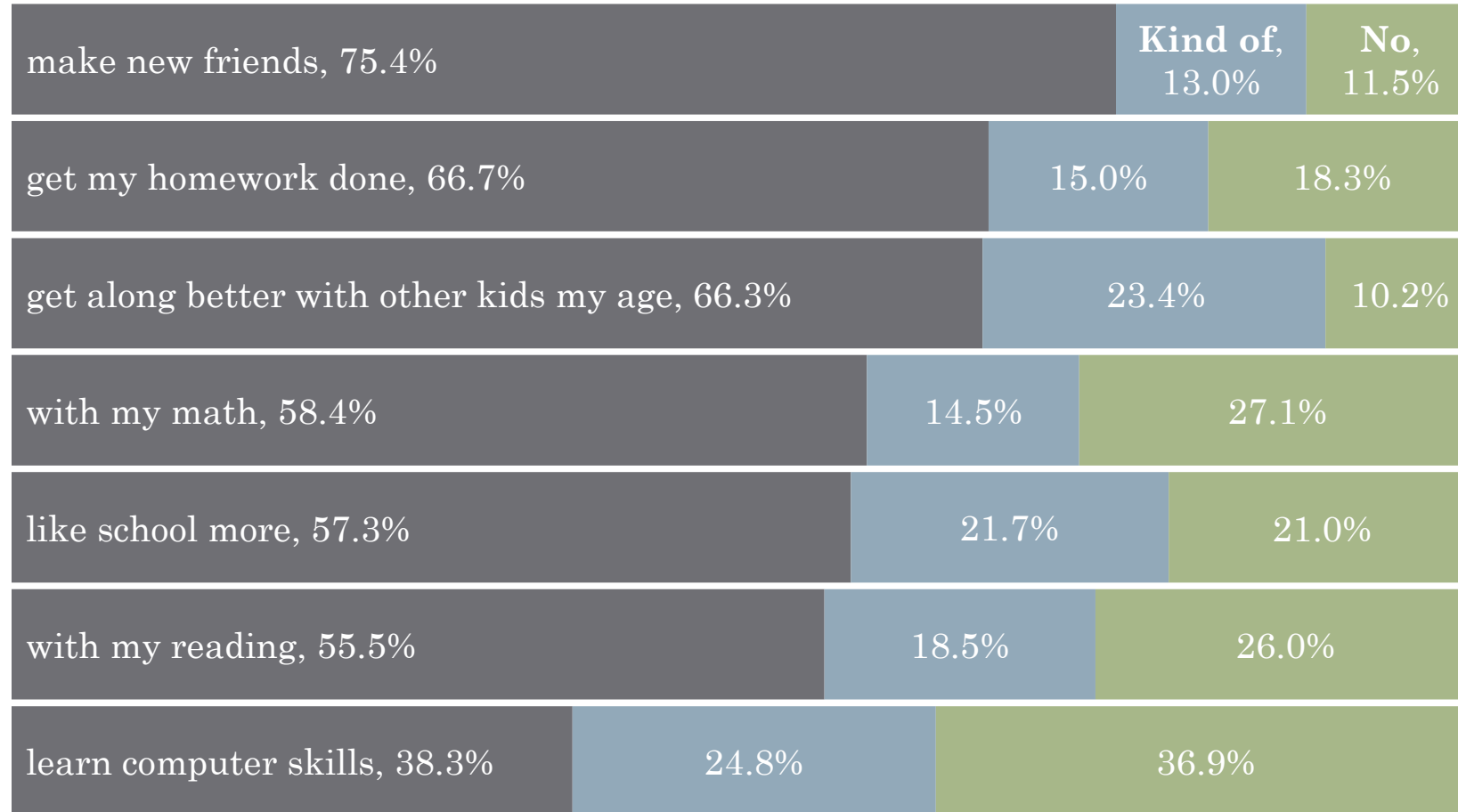

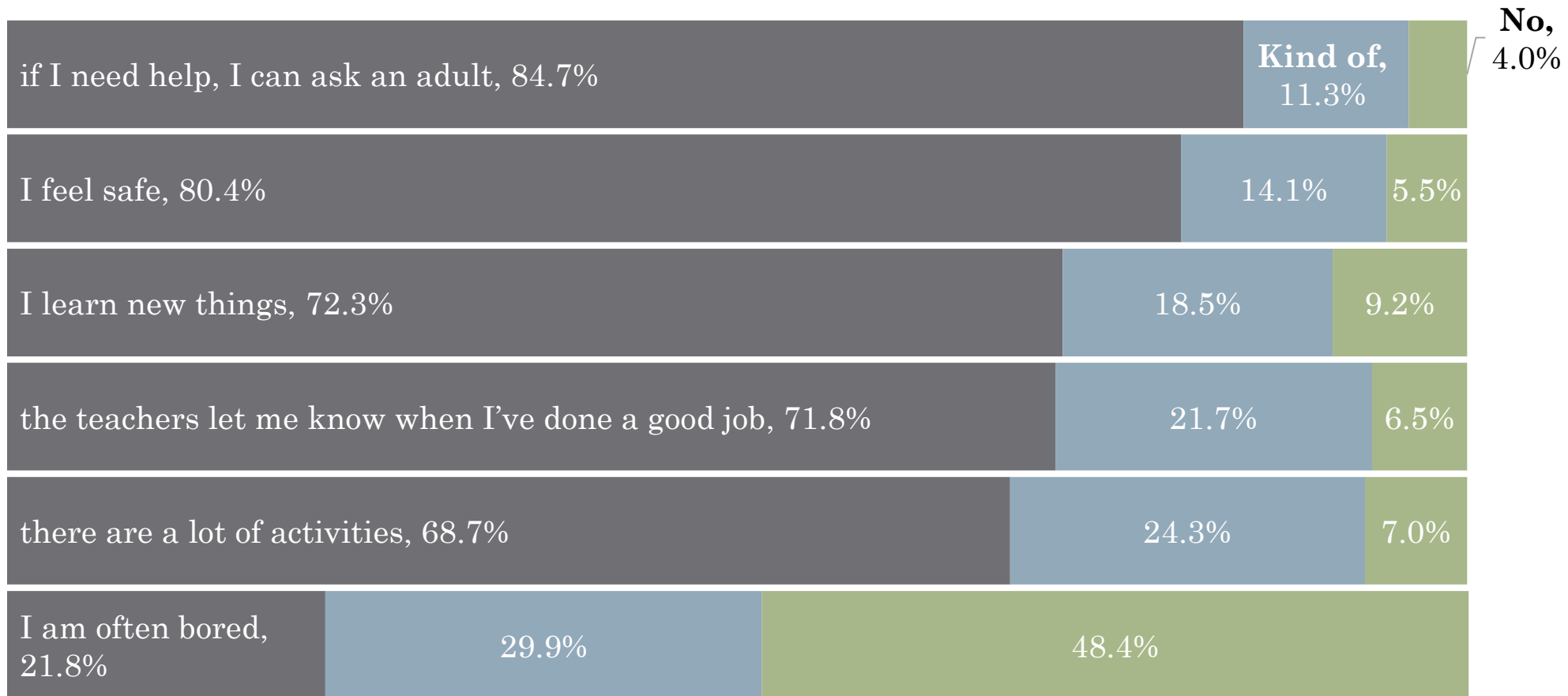

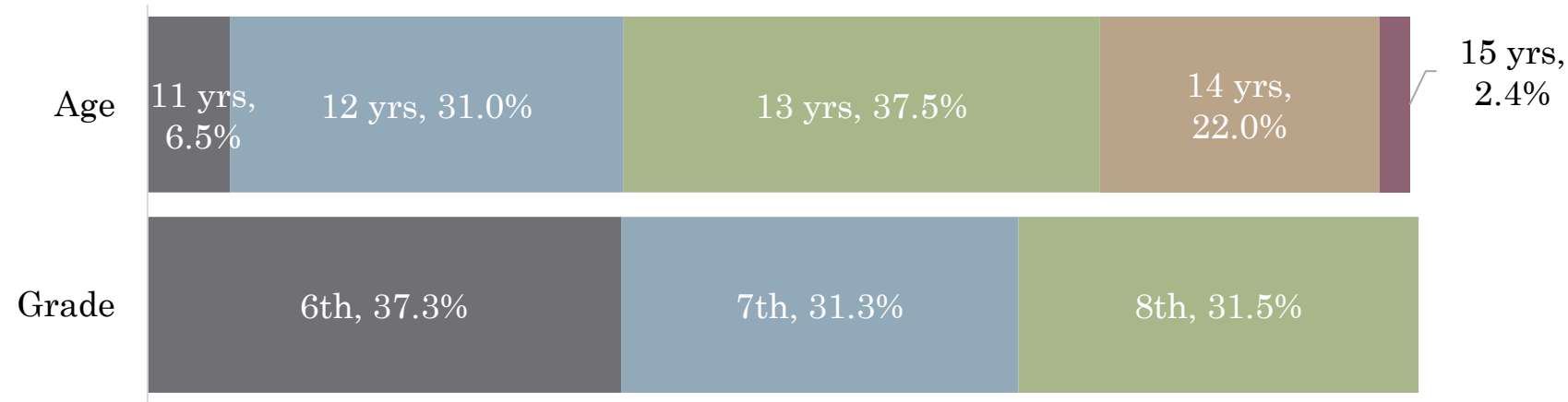

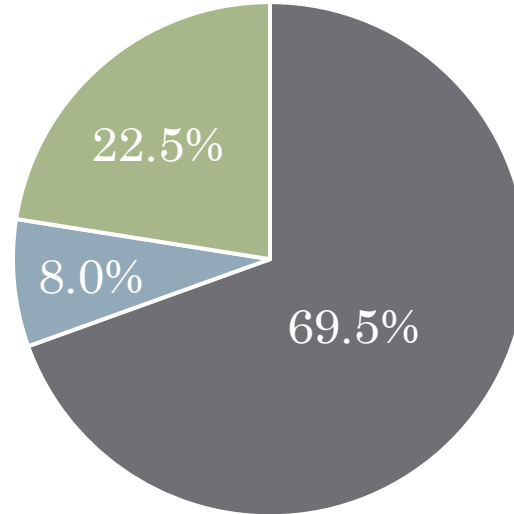


# Middle School Findings

 4 – Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, 1.0%; 5 – Asian American, 0.6%

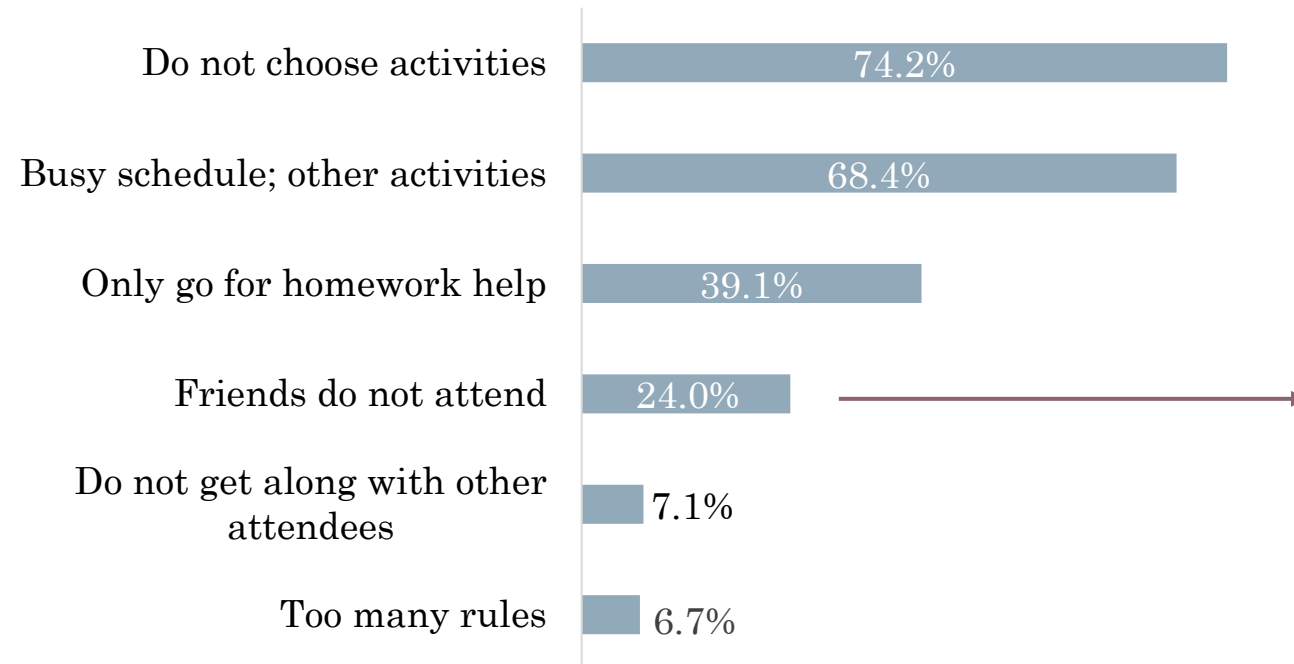
# MS – Attendance

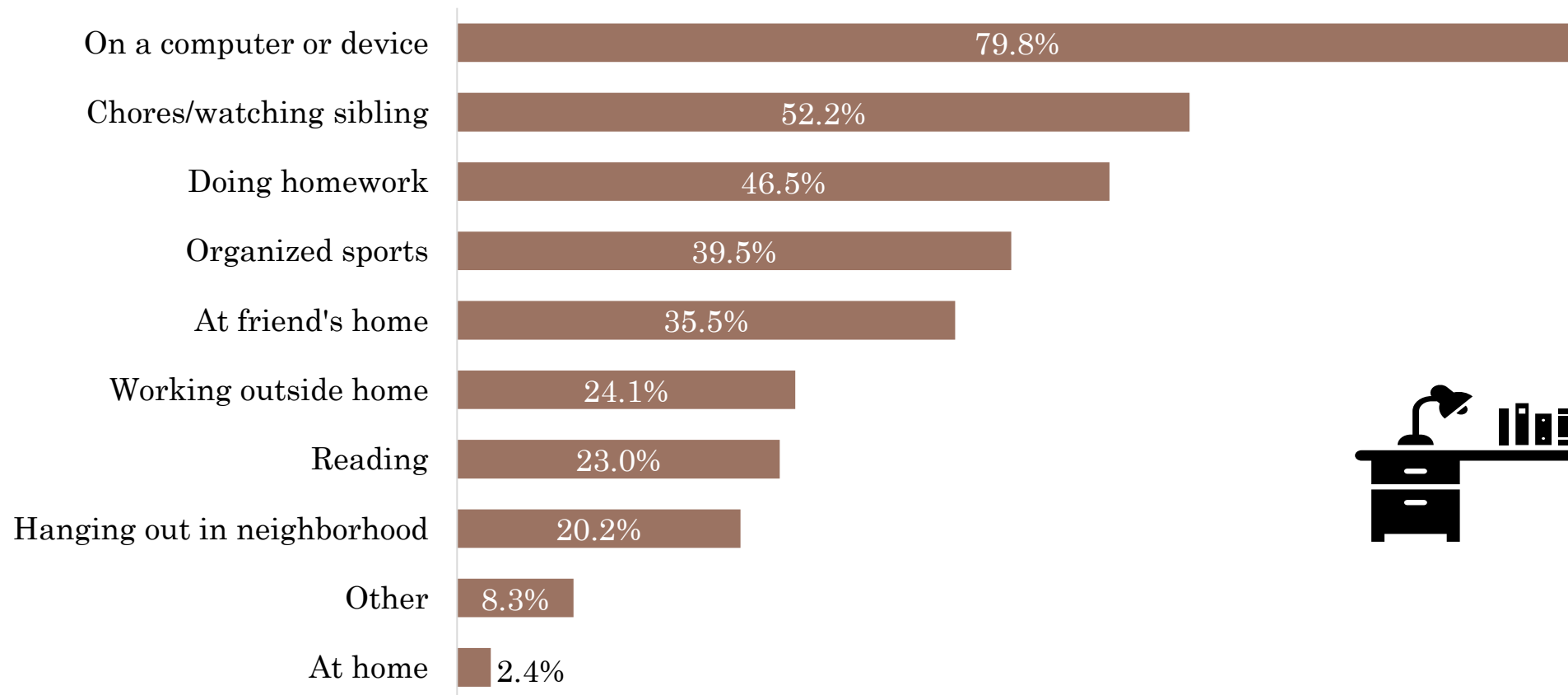
# MS – Attendance continued



## Reasons their friends do not attend:

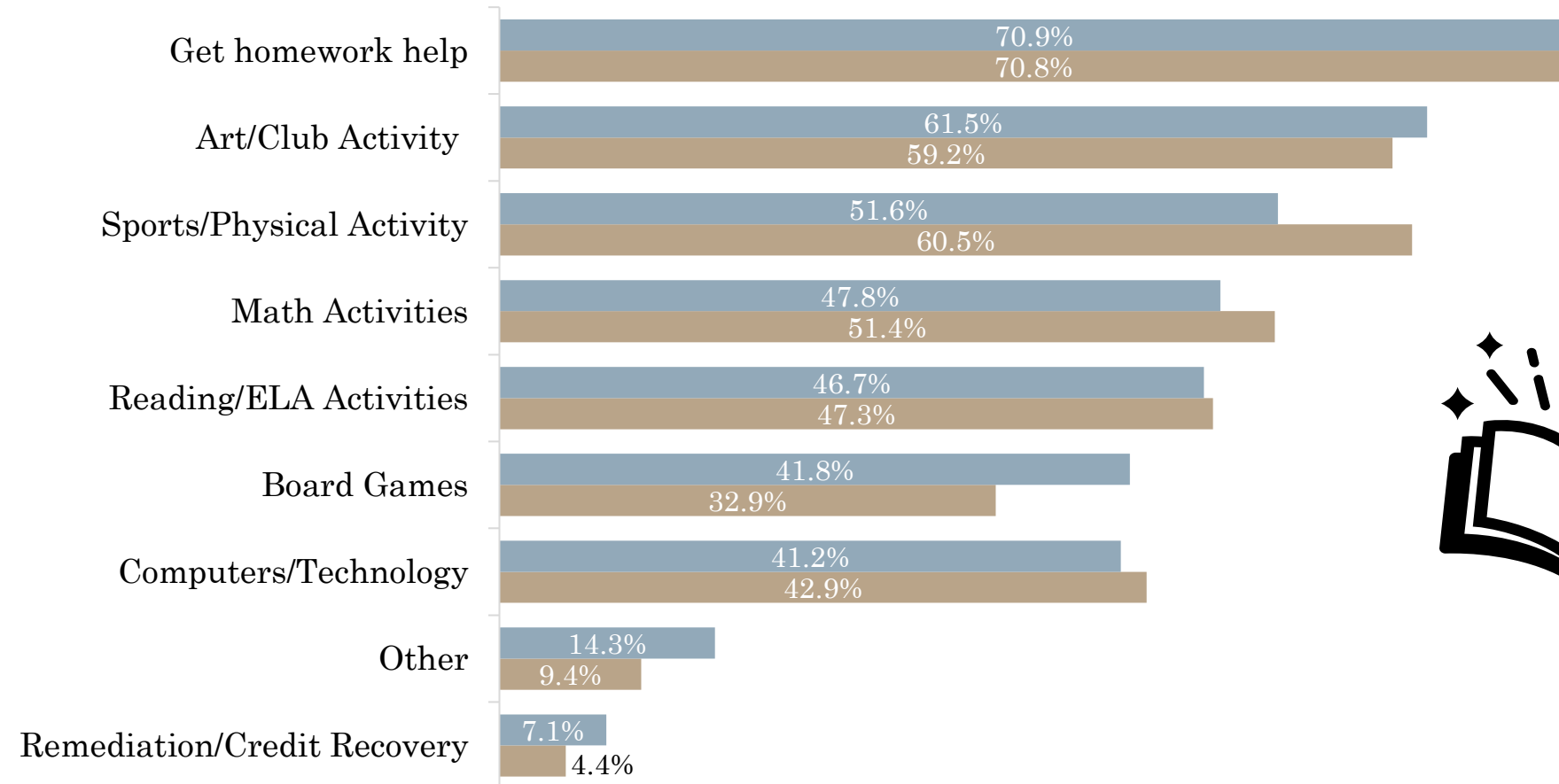
- Have to go home (62%)

# If not attending an ELP after school, students reported they would be doing the following activities:



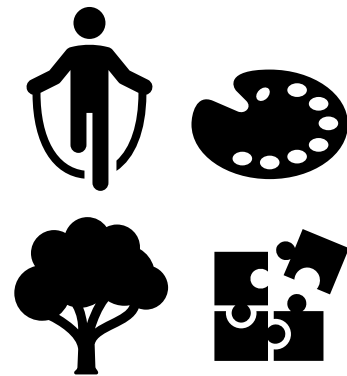
# MS – ELP Activities

Activities done at ELP for those who attended *once a week or less* and who attended *at least twice a week*:

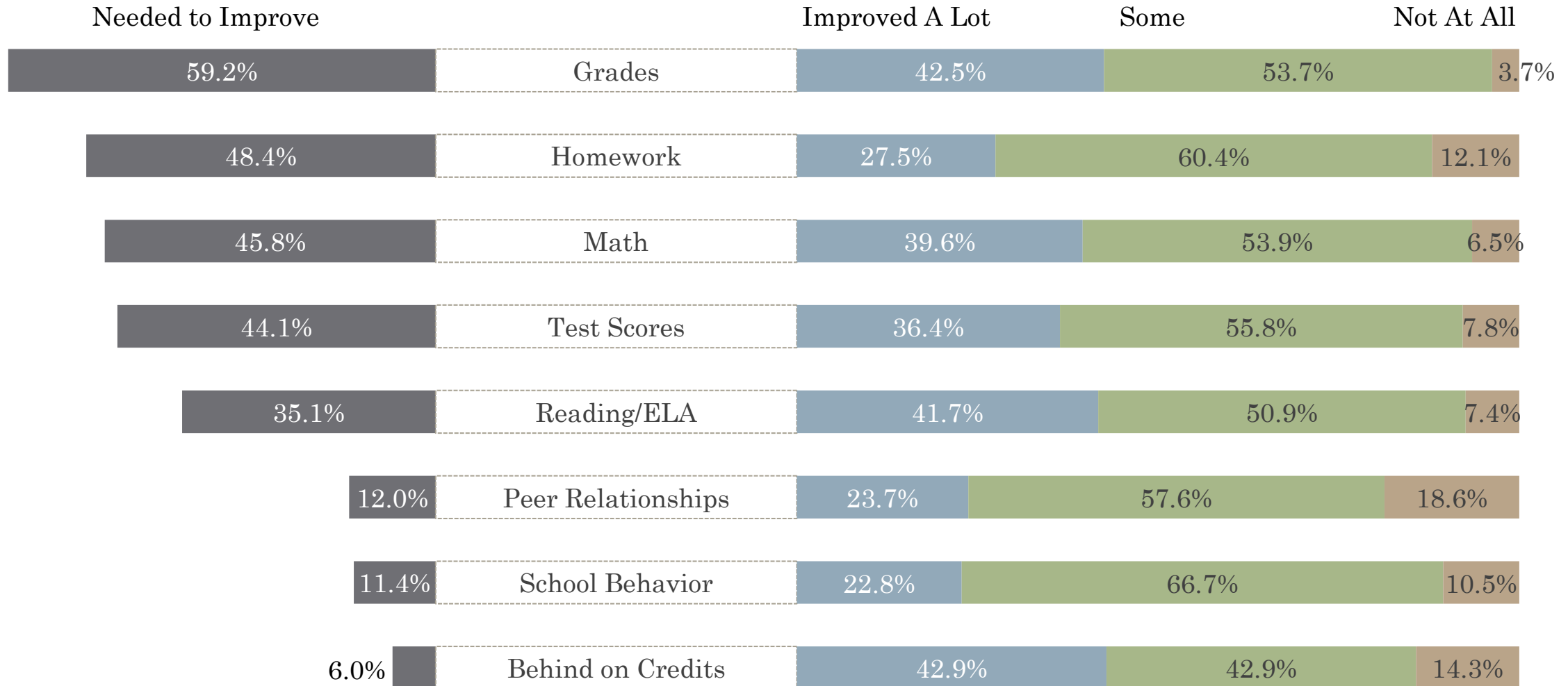


“If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?”:

- **38** requested *Arts and Crafts*
- **32** requested *Free Time and/or Phone Time*
- **29** requested *Outdoor Time / Activities*
- **22** requested *Games* (e.g., board games)
- **18** requested *Baking / Cooking*

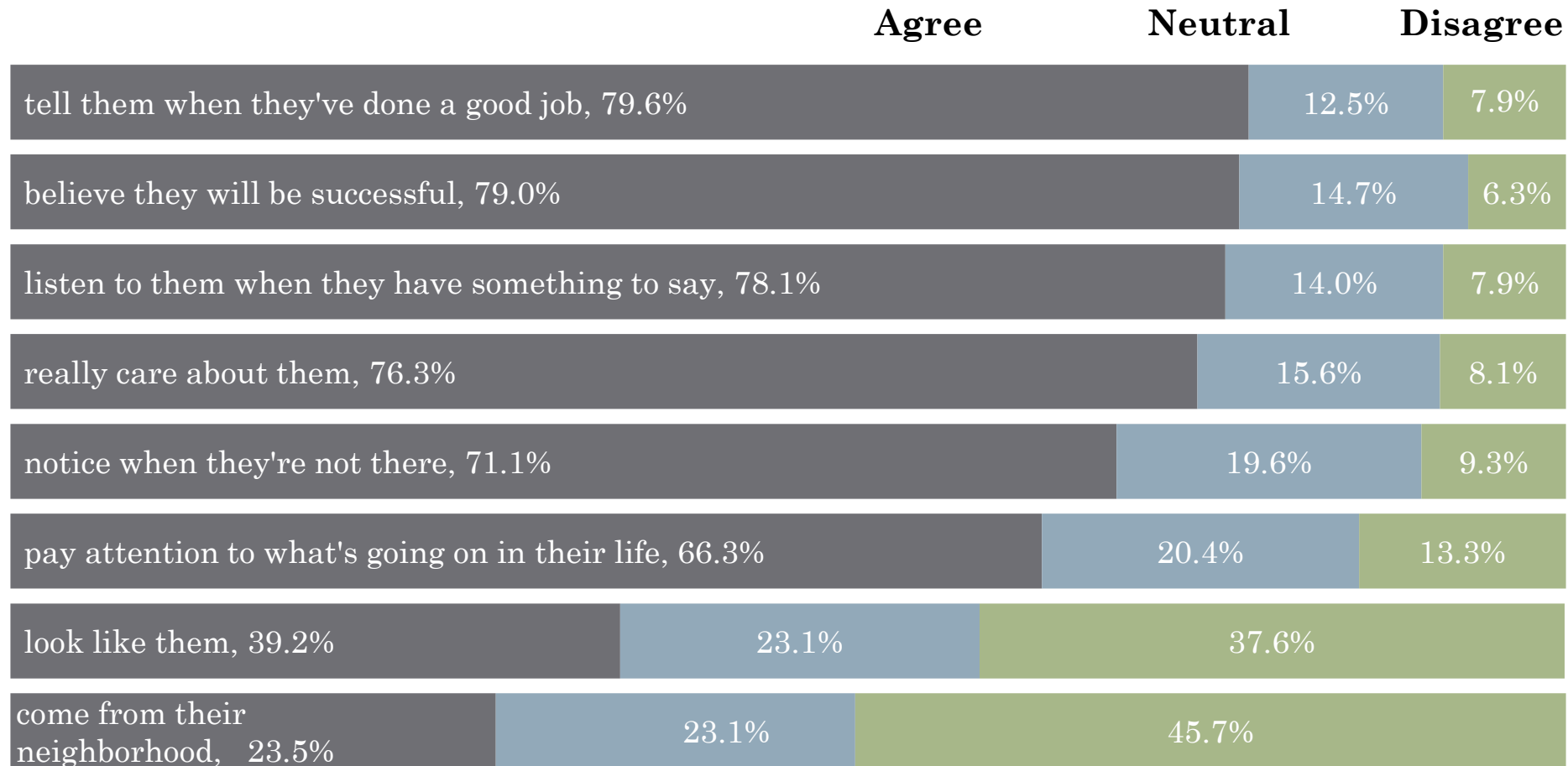

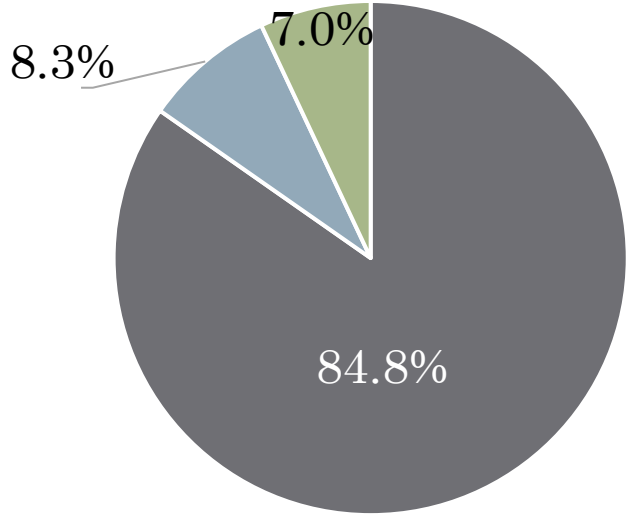

4 – American Indian or Alaska Native, 0.6%; 5 – Asian American, 0.6%

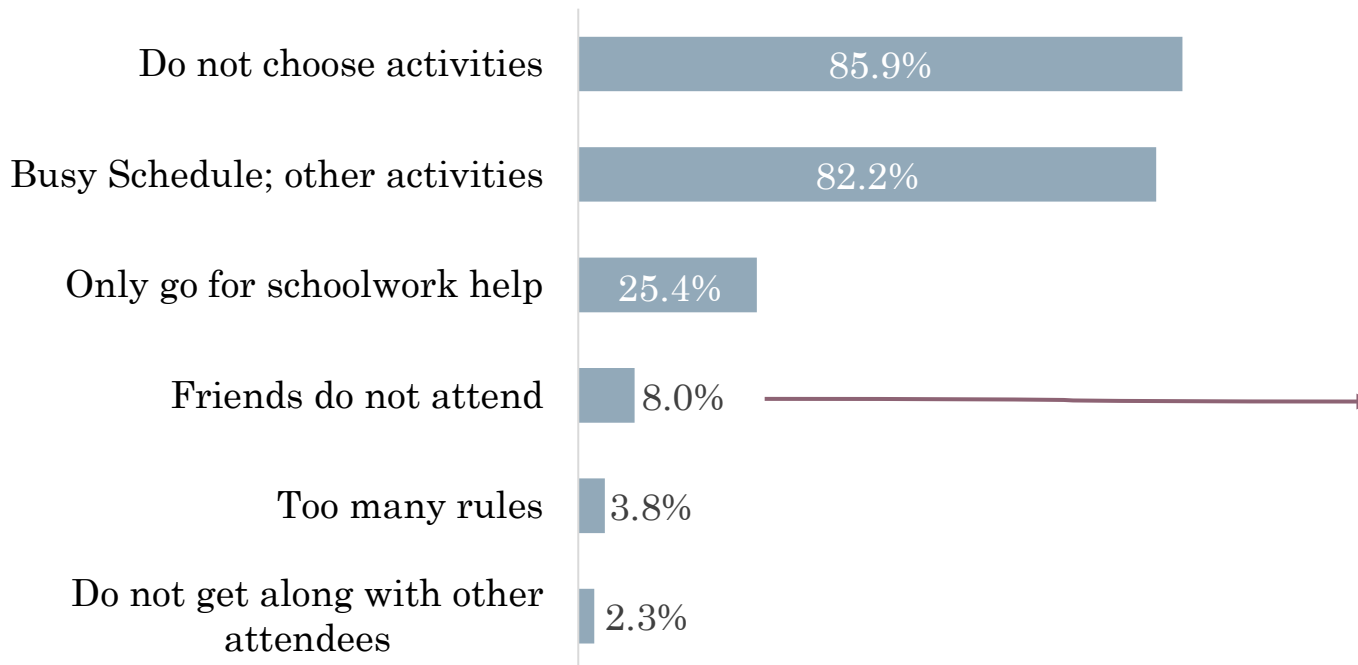
# HS – Attendance



■ PM Only ■ AM Only ■ Both



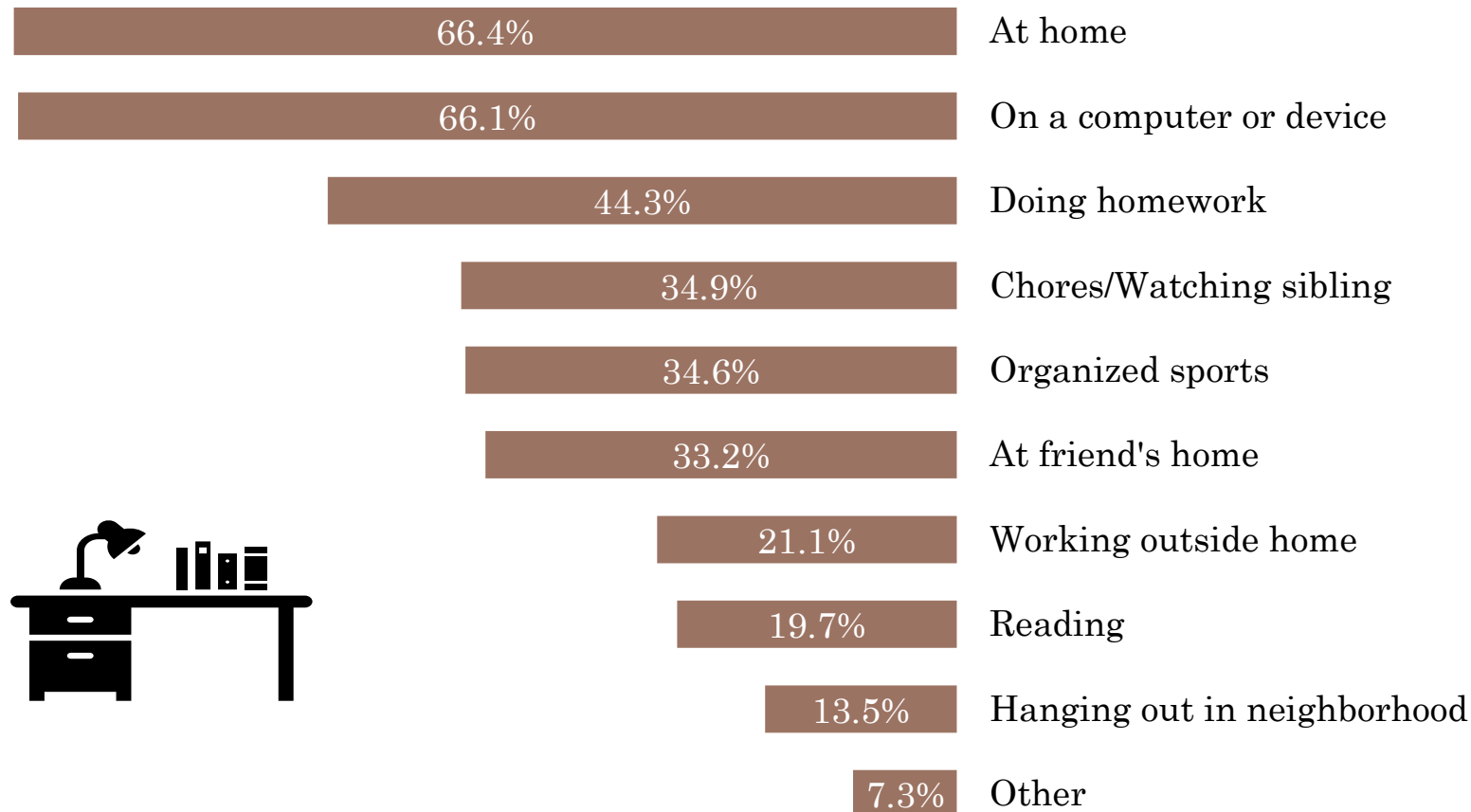
# HS – Attendance continued



Reasons their friends do not attend:

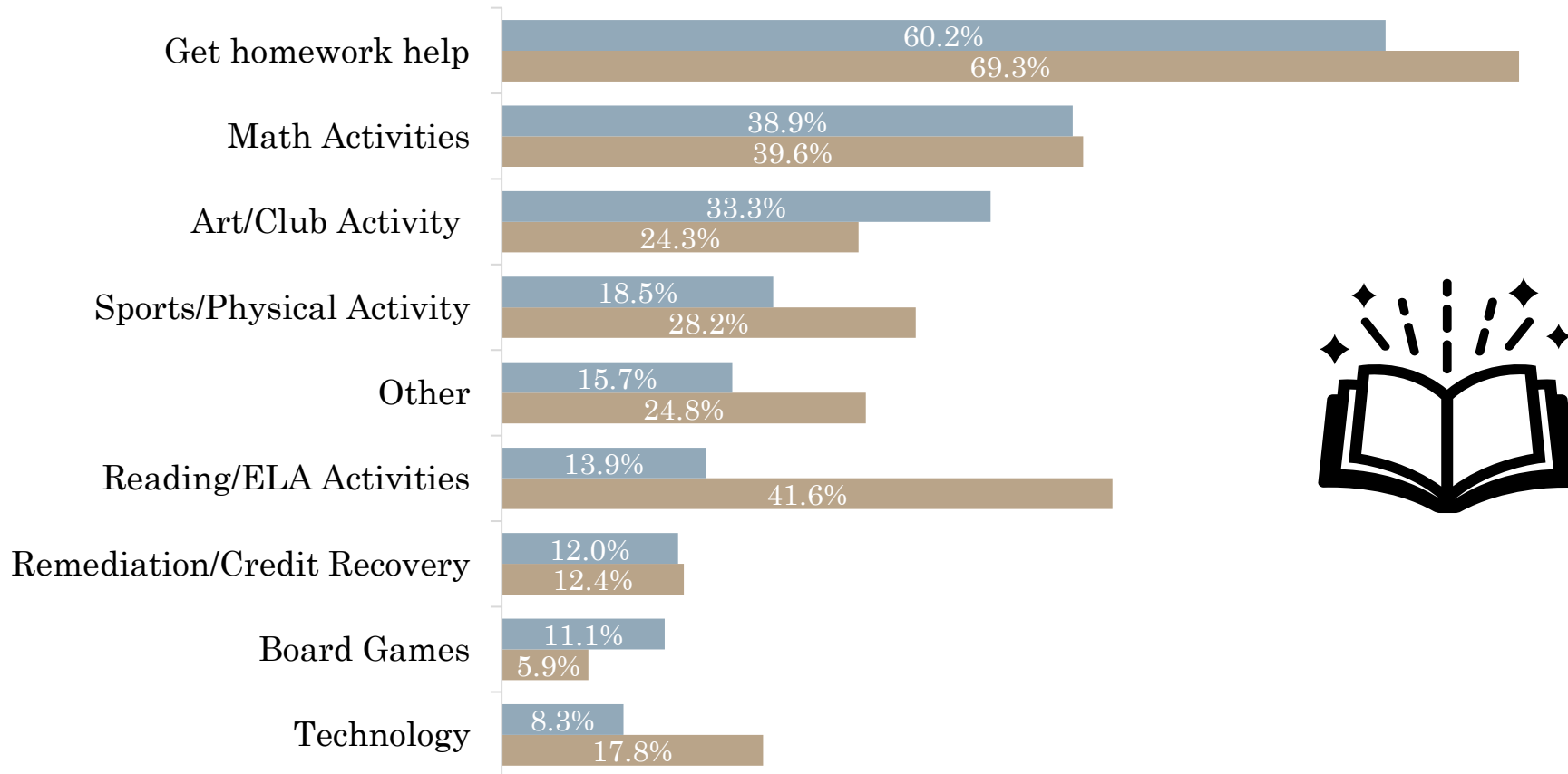
- Have to go home (47.1%)

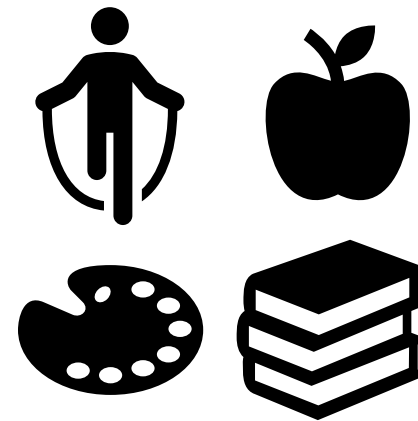

Activities done at ELP for those who attended *once a week or less* and who attended *at least twice a week*:



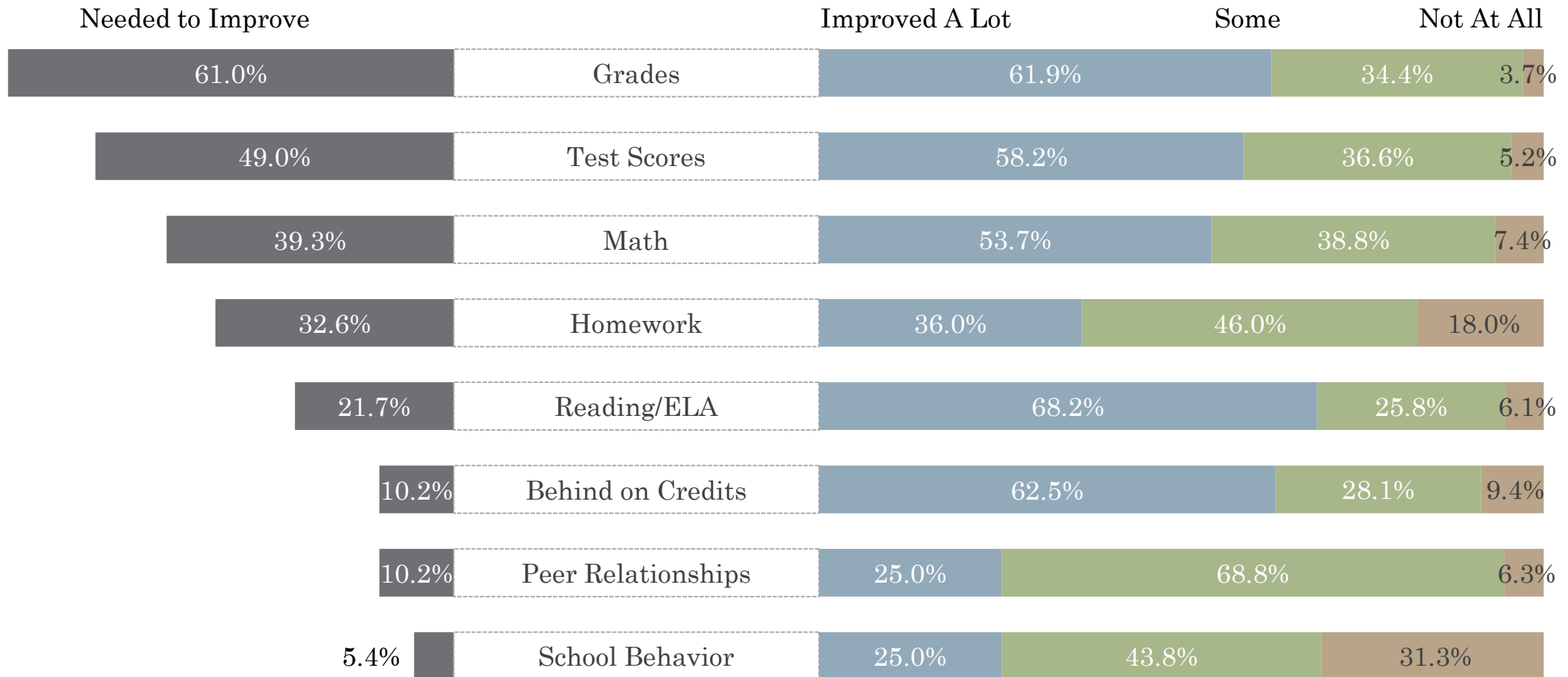
“If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?”:

- **10** requested *Games (e.g., board games)*

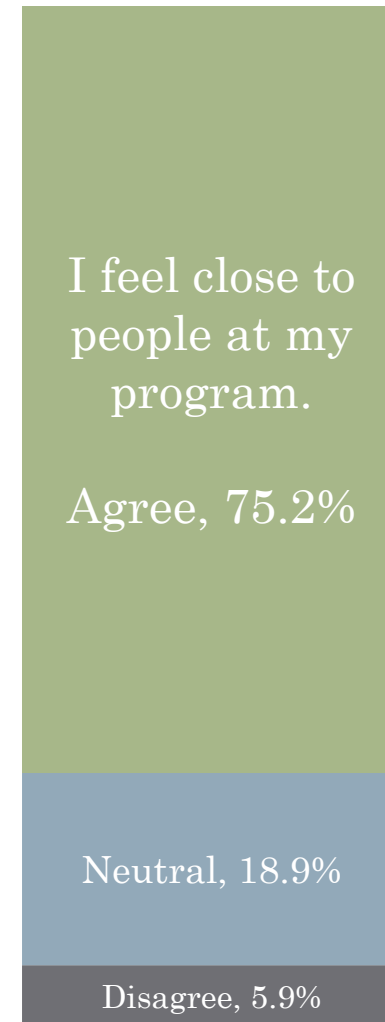
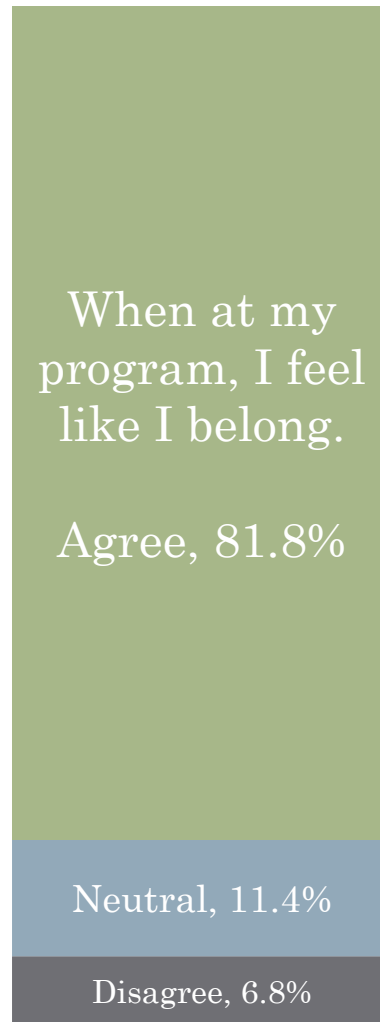
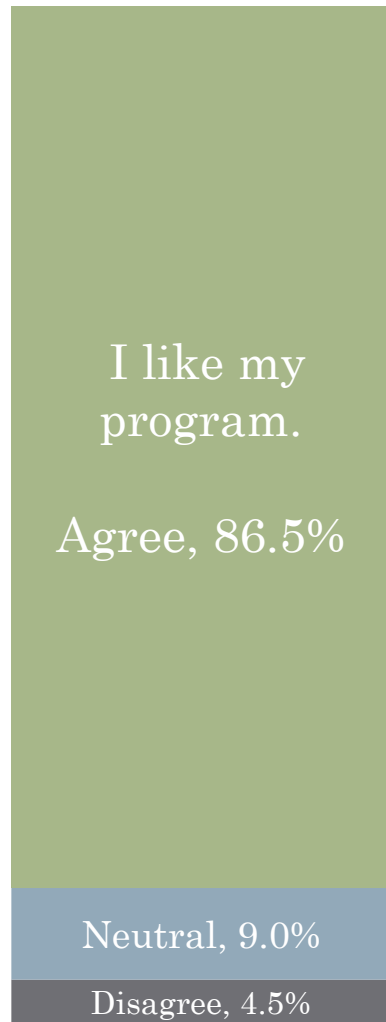




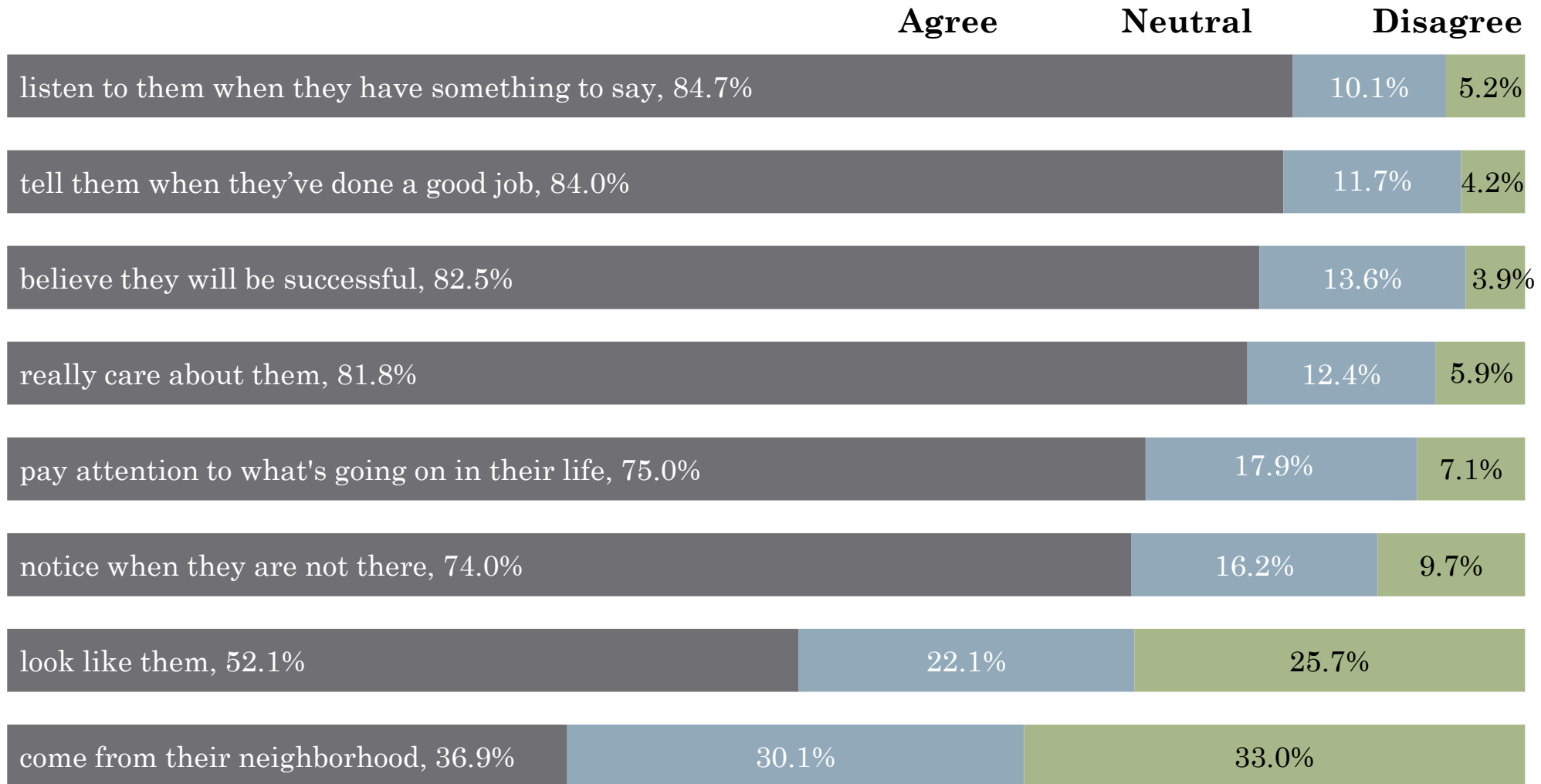
