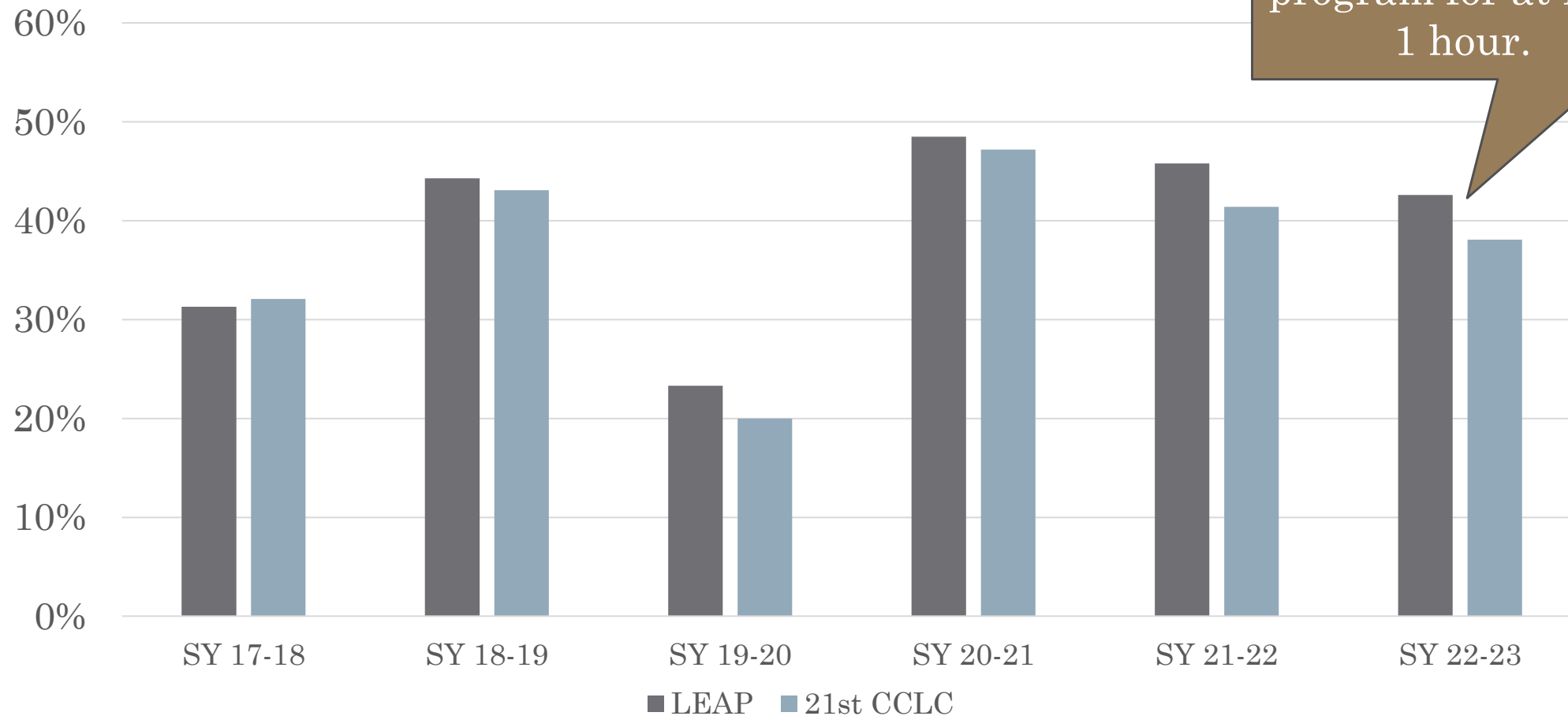

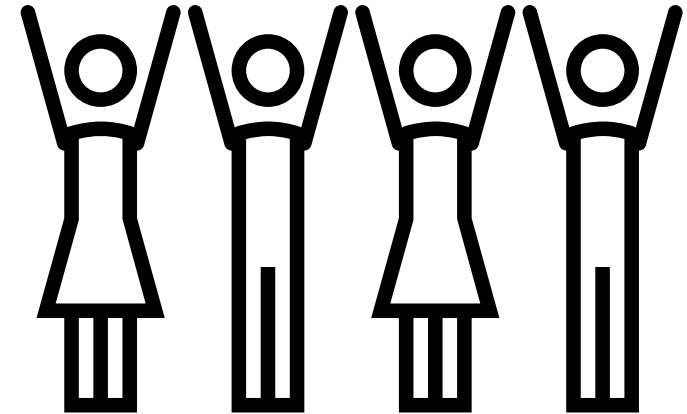
# Response Rates – 1+ Hours



Last year, Teachers completed surveys for 39.6% of those who attended a program for at least 1 hour.

# 2022-2023 Findings

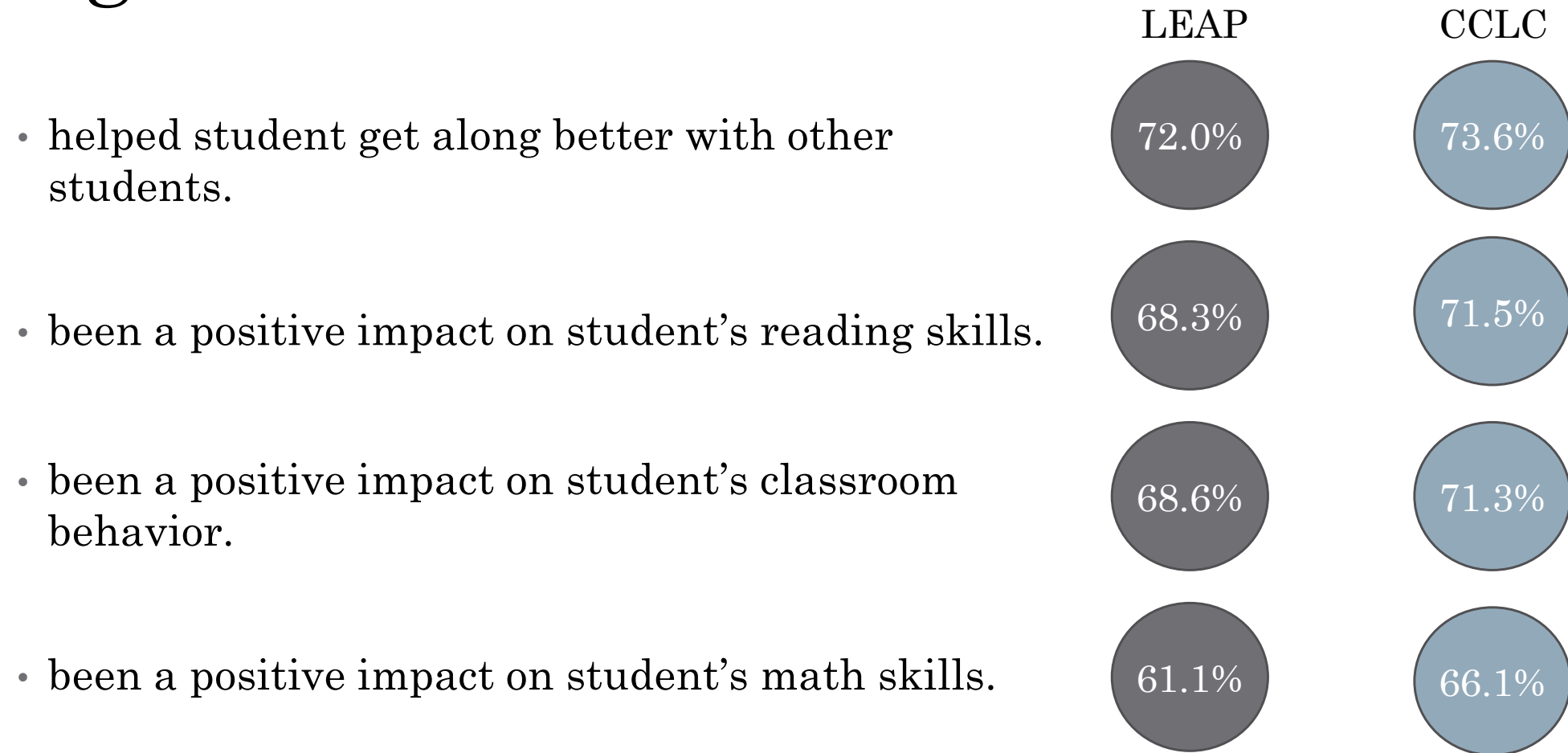
- 3 out of 4 teachers are very or extremely satisfied with the communication they receive from the ELP.
- 6 out of 10 teachers think the program has benefitted the student a lot or a great deal.



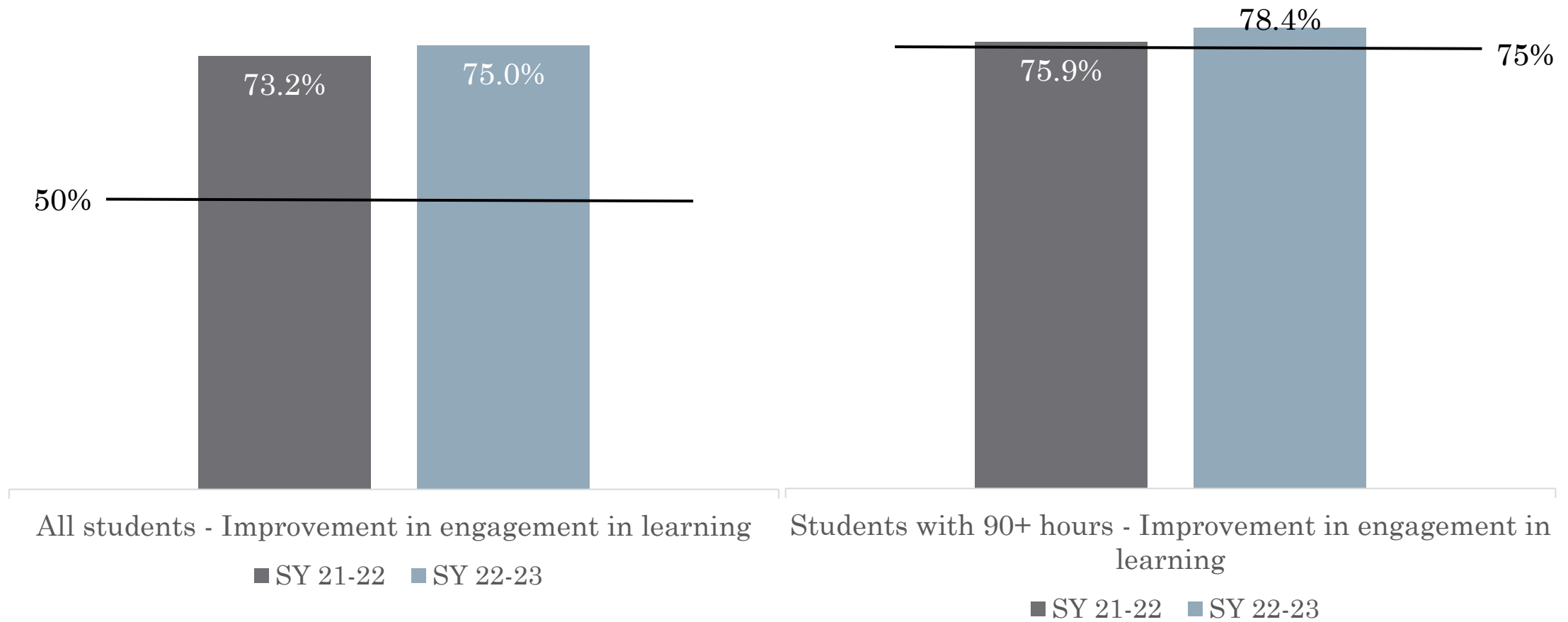
# Teachers who Agree or Strongly Agree the ELP has:

• helped student be more self-confident in interactions with peers.	77.5%	78.5%
• helped improve student's level of class participation.	73.6%	76.1%
• helped student complete homework assignments with fewer mistakes.	71.1%	75.9%
• helped student complete homework assignments in a more timely manner.	70.7%	75.6%

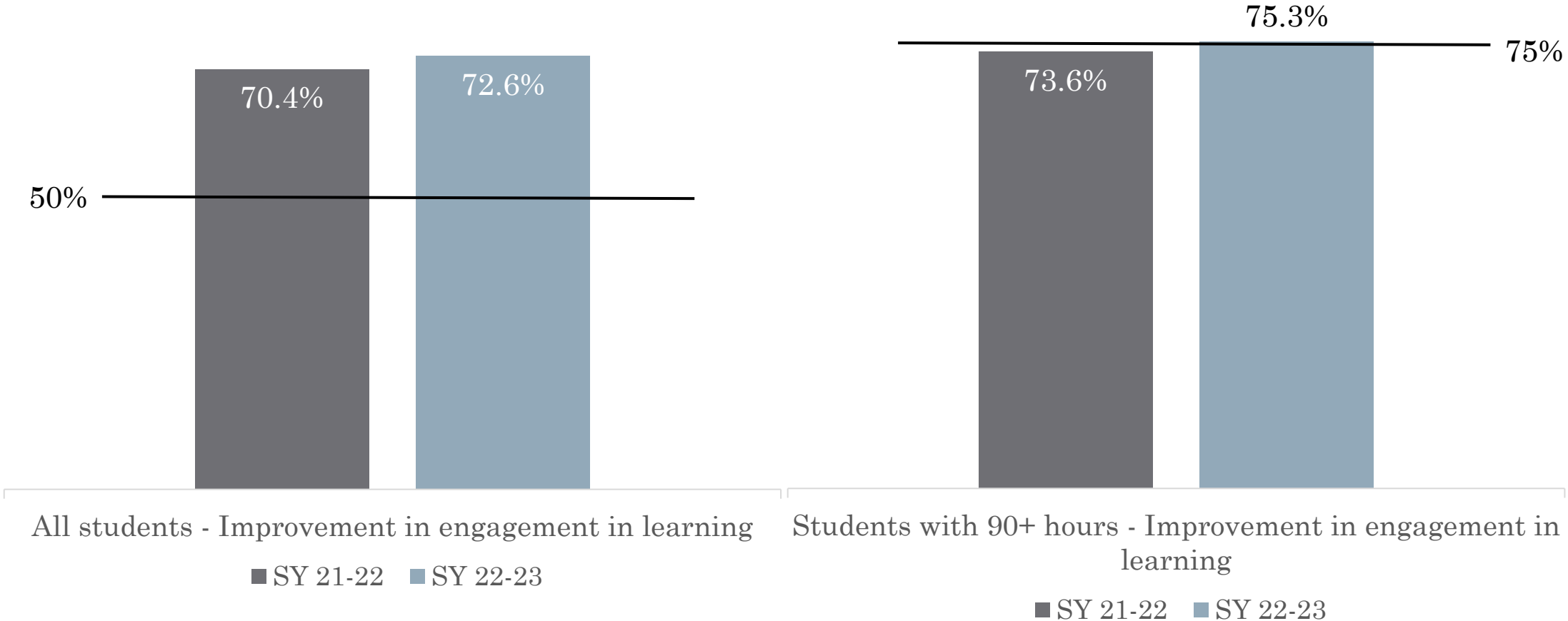
