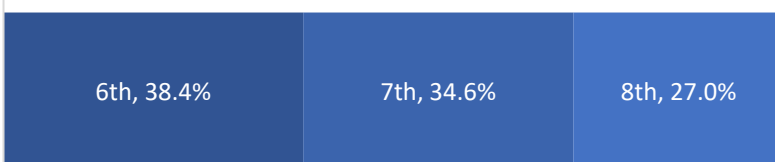

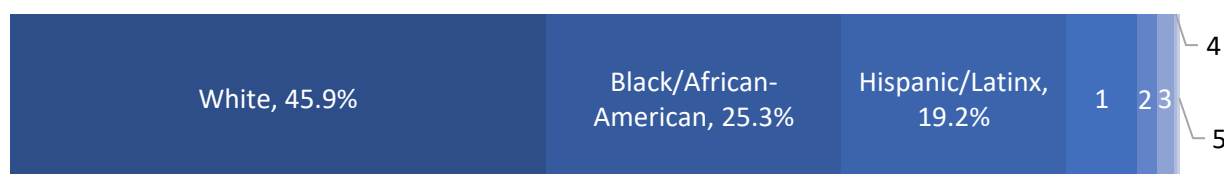

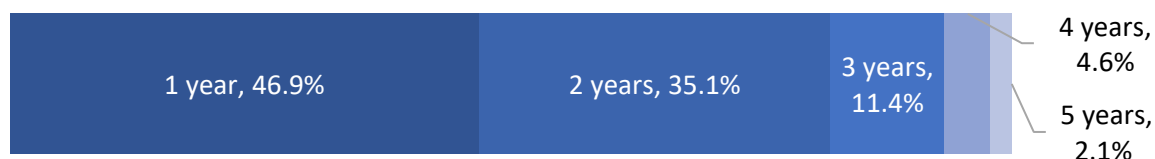

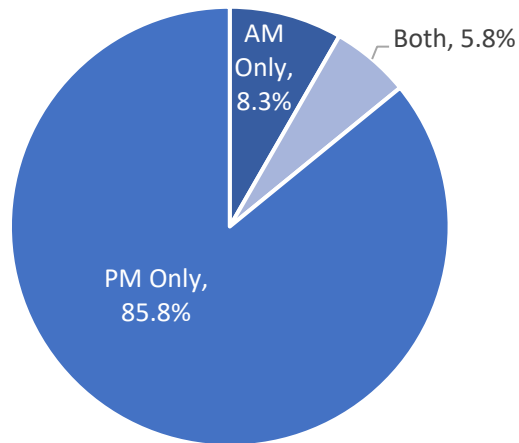

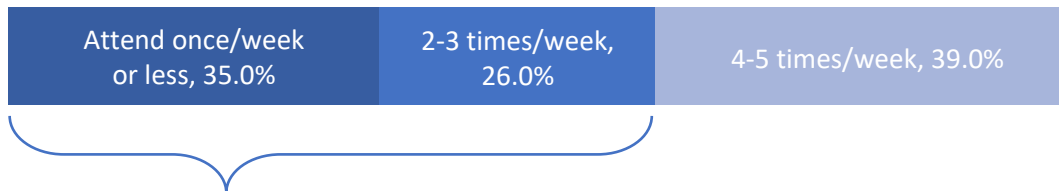

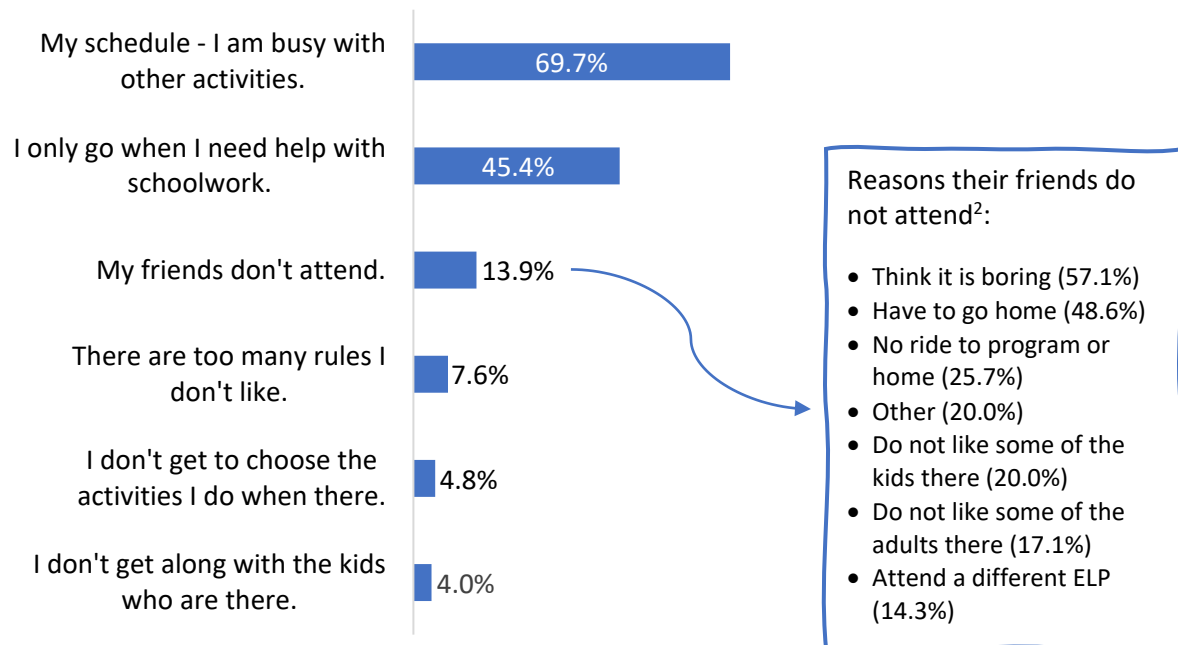

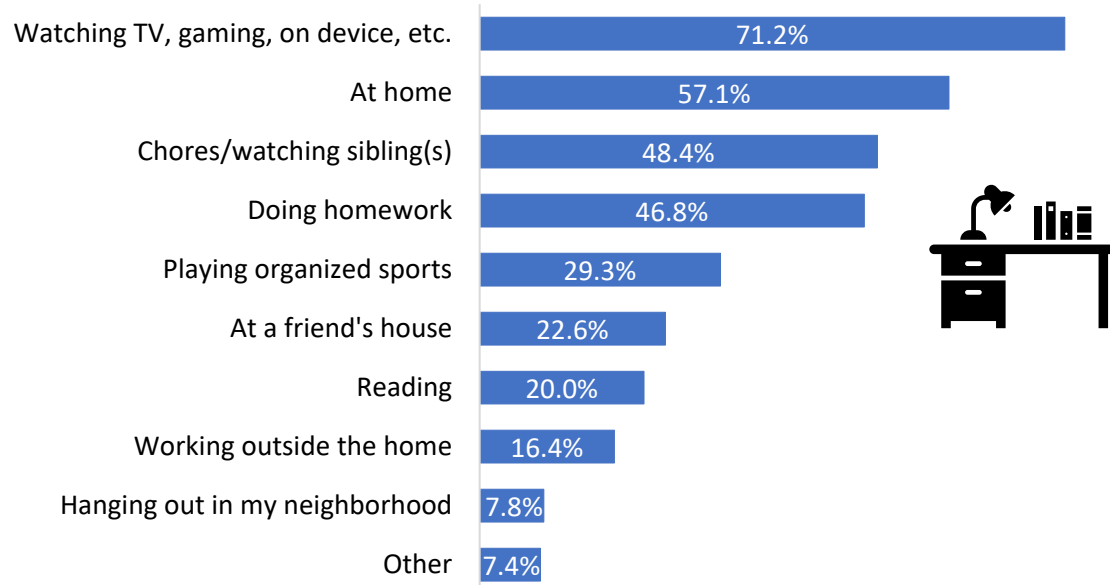


Of the students who reported attending *3 times per week or less* despite the program being open when they are not attending (293, 61%), the following are reasons they do not attend more frequently ²:



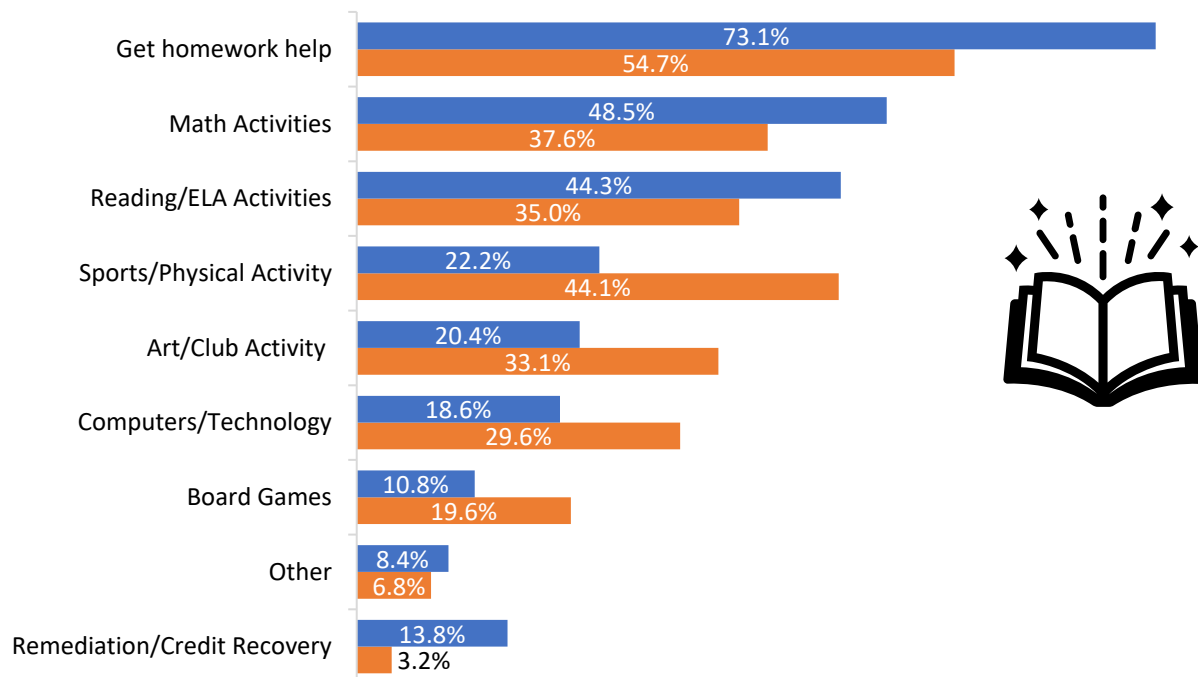

Students provided short-answer responses to the following question - **“If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?”**:

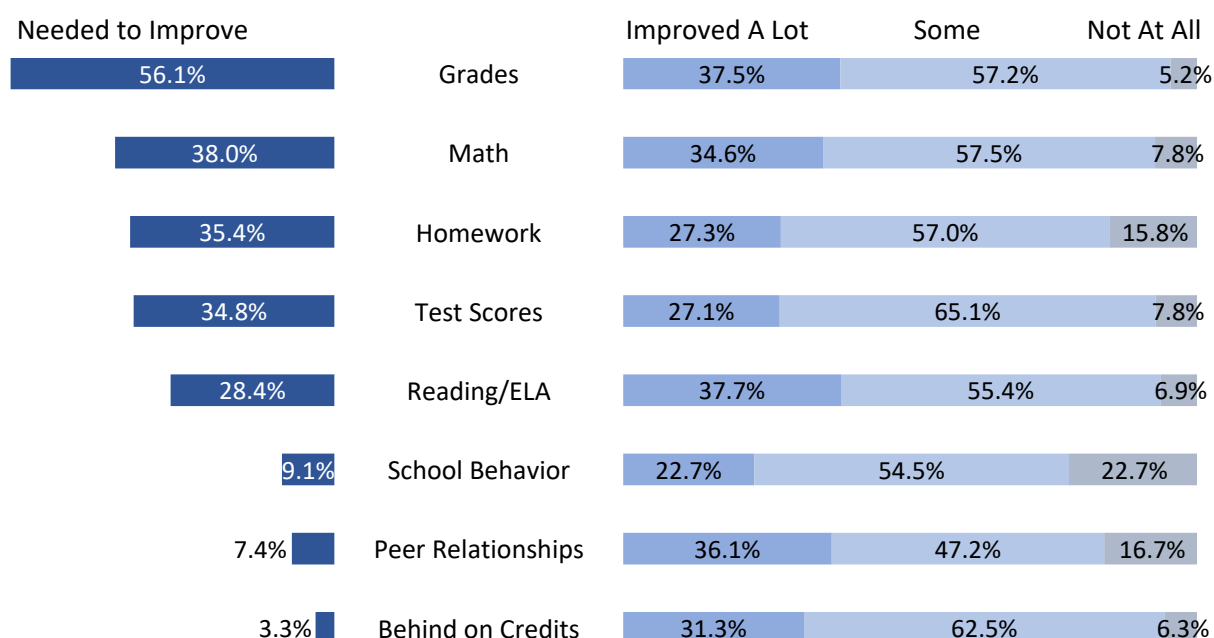
99 students requested *Sports/Physical Activity/Dance*

31 requested *Outdoor Time/Activities*
31 requested *Baking/Cooking*
30 requested *Free Time and/or Phone Time*
26 requested *Studying/Tutoring/Homework*
15 requested *STEM/Robotics*

Other activities mentioned: *Reading/Writing* (12), *Music/Band* (10), *Video Games/Gaming* (9), *Life Skills* (6), *Relaxation/Nap* (5), *Drama* (4), *Mental Health* (3), *Field Trips* (2), *Learn Language* (2)

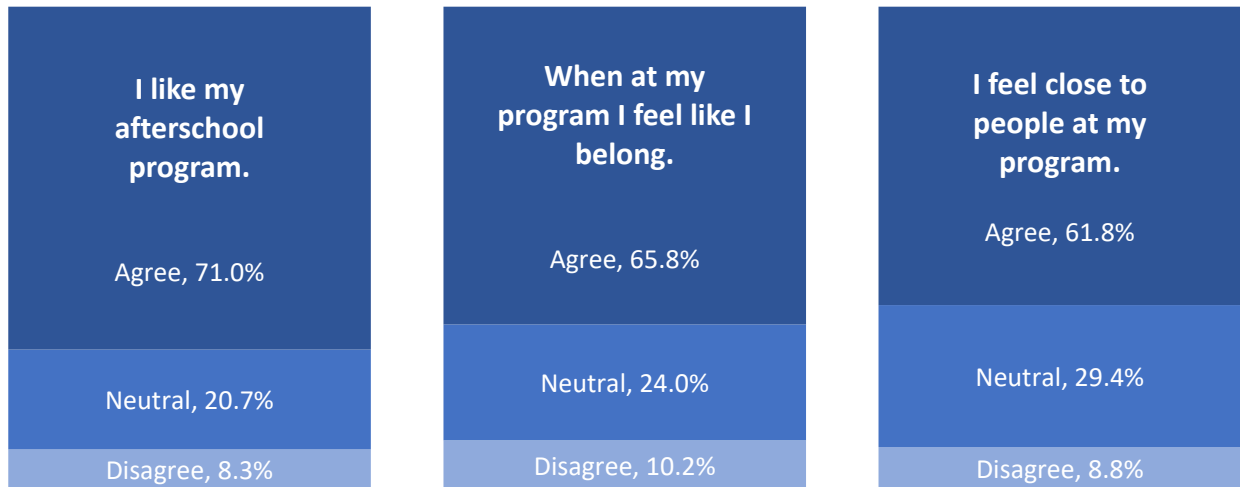


Student Perceptions
