

# **Extended Learning Programs Student Survey**




#### Race/Ethnicity



#### **Current Participation:**













#### **ELP Activities**

Students provided short-answer responses to the following question - "If you were responsible for designing an afterschool program, what is one activity you would include?":

**15** requested *STEM/Robotics*

## **Student Perceptions**

Students who said they needed to improve in the following areas then reported how much they felt they had improved during the school year<sup>4</sup>:

Students reported that adults at their program: Agree Neutral Disagree believe they will be successful, 77.4% 17.0% listen to them when they have something to say, 76.5% 16.3% tell them when they've done a good job, 74.7% 15.6% really care about them, 68.6% 22.6% notice when they're not there, 63.9% 23.6% pay attention to what's going on in their life, 59.2% 27.7% look like them, 34.1% 17.2% come from their neighborhood, 20.0% 20.6%
